



## **Metro Athletic Conference Filling Vacancy**

The Metro Athletic Conference is currently looking to fill a vacancy beginning in the 2028-29 school year. No decision has yet been made if the League will remain an 8-team League or look to add additional schools to the Conference.

For the 2026-27 school year the MAC will be a League of 10 schools (Cloverleaf, Cuyahoga Falls, Brimfield Field, Kent Roosevelt, Norton, Ravenna, Akron Springfield, Streetsboro, Tallmadge, and Woodridge). Three (3) schools will be leaving the League over the next two years, Cloverleaf after the 2027-28 school year and both Ravenna and Springfield after the 2026-27 school year.

The MAC not only focuses on providing competitive athletics, but also strives to provide the student-athlete with programs focusing on leadership, accountability, mental health, and sportsmanship.
