Summer 10-Day Rule

There is some confusion with the 10-Day rule as it relates to football. Let's try to clear it up.

- 1. The 50% rule in 7.3.1 does not apply to football.
- 2. The 7-player skill instruction policy is year-round except for the no-contact period.
- The 10-Day General Sports Regulation 7.5.5 is as follows: Members of a school team's coaching staff in the team sports of baseball, basketball, field hockey, football, ice hockey, lacrosse, soccer, softball and volleyball may coach students from their school teams for a maximum of 10 days from June 1 through July 31. Note: The entire acclimatization period may be completed in July from 7/18 through 7/31. This cannot be mandatory!
