**SUBJECT:** Boys and Girls Soccer Post-Season Information

#### POST-SEASON INFORMATION

#### Mandatory No Contact Period – 28 Days after the completion of the season

Per GSR 11, coaches are not permitted to coach or provide skill instruction to team members for the period of time starting with the first day after the school's last interscholastic contest (tournament or regular season) and ending 28 days later. This includes any type of tryouts in or out of school for purposes of non-interscholastic competition.

#### 2024 Regular Season Dates

Aug. 1, 2024 First day of coaching
Aug. 16, 2024 First date of competition
Sept. 2, 2024 Non-interscholastic date

The start date allows teams to highlight a soccer match on a Friday night under the lights. Teams are not required to start on the first date of competition. Teams may play a maximum of 17 regular season contests anytime beginning Aug. 16, 2024, through the state finals.

## **OUT-OF-SEASON UPDATES AND REMINDERS**

# **Indoor Soccer**

Indoor Soccer is defined as a game played by two teams, each consisting of no more than six players, and played indoors. There is no limit to the number of players from the same school that may be on an indoor soccer team and school coaches may coach their own players on an indoor soccer team.

## <u>Futsal</u>

The sport of Futsal is considered a different sport than soccer. Therefore, the OHSAA regulations do not apply to any participation in this sport.

### Non-Interscholastic Participation

- **1. Limitation:** For the sport of soccer, no more than six (6) student-athletes from the same school may participate on the same non-school team.
  - Graduating seniors are not counted.
  - Student-athletes who did not trigger member of a team status are not counted.
  - 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> grade are separate from 9-12 (e.g. A 14U team may have six 8<sup>th</sup> graders and six 9<sup>th</sup> graders)

Dates	Participation Limitation
August 1 – May 14	6-player limitation is in effect.
May 15 – July 31	If the school coach <u>IS</u> coaching, the 6-player limitation is in effect.  If the school coach <u>IS NOT</u> coaching, then there is no limit to the number of players from the school team that may participate on the non-school team.
28 days after the season	No Contact Period

**2. Rotating Players:** The act of rotating players is defined as rotating/switching players on a non-interscholastic team roster throughout the non-interscholastic team's season due to absence or injury. Rotating players from the same school team is not permitted within the player limitation. ## Illegal Uniform Penalty - EFFECTIVE AUGUST 1, 2026

In accordance with NFHS Rule 4.1, teams who are found to be in violation of the uniform requirements shall be subject to a \$100 fine per occurrence. Failure to have NFHS complaint uniforms by the start of the OHSAA post season shall result in removal from the OHSAA Tournament.
