Space Remains for All Schools to Attend OHSAA Student Leadership Conference

The OHSAA Student Leadership Conference will be held on Tuesday, Oct. 22, at Cincinnati Princeton High School's Matthews Auditorium, and administrators at all OHSAA schools are encouraged to attend along with their student-athletes, coaches and other staff members. Check-in for the free event begins at 8:30 a.m., the conference will run from 9:00 until 1:30 and lunch will be provided. To register, follow these instructions:

- 3.) Then select the "Have a passcode?" option and enter the code "SLC2024"

 Note: This code is designed to give you access to the ticket level and is to be entered PRIOR to selecting your ticket

The conference is designed to provide students with the tools to create a transformational culture, one that builds strong character and leadership traits. Featured speakers will be **Doug Ute**, OHSAA Executive Director; **Tom Burton**, an educational consultant; **Hoan Do**, an international speaker, author and ninja; **Shawn Harper**, a former NFL player who is now a business and national speaker; **Rick Metzger**, a former world champion power lifter and current longtime professional speaker **Otis Winston**, a former OHSAA state high jump champion who played basketball at Ohio State and is now a professional actor, writer and producer, and **Harvey Alston**, coordinator of the OHSAA student leadership conferences and a "high octane" public speaker since 1989 who is CEO of Best, Inc.

NEW! OHSAA State Football Finals Ticket Sales Begin Monday

All-session and indoor Stadium Club tickets, single-day packages and a team one-day discount package go on sale Monday, Oct. 21, for the 2024 OHSAA State Football Finals that will be held Dec. 5-7 at Tom Benson Hall of Fame Stadium in Canton. Stadium Club all-session tickets include free access to tour the Pro Football Hall of Fame during the state championship weekend. The Pro Football Hall of Fame and Hall of Fame Village are located adjacent to the stadium. Tickets for the state football finals, and all OHSAA postseason tournament contests in all sports, are available at www.OHSAA.org/tickets. Single-game tickets for the football state finals will be on sale at a later date.

ALL-SESSION STADIUM CLUB: All-session Stadium Club tickets are \$150 each and provide one ticket to all seven games in a theater style seat as well as access to the indoor club level of the press box containing its own concessions. Patrons with club access do not need to exit the stadium between games. The all-session Stadium Club package also includes access to tour the Pro Football Hall of Fame during the OHSAA Football State Championship weekend. A limited number of all-session Stadium Club tickets that include a parking pass are also available for \$210 each. These ticket holders will receive a parking hangtag for the weekend valid for a lot near the stadium.

ALL-SESSION GENERAL ADMISSION OR SINGLE-DAY PACKAGES: Other options include all-session general admission tickets that are \$90 for adults and \$60 for students, or three-game, single-day packages for Friday or Saturday games only that cost \$75 for Club Seating or \$40 for adults or \$30 for students for general admission seating.

TEAM ONE-DAY DISCOUNT PACKAGE: Additionally, a one-day discount package is available for football teams from elementary through high school. Teams can choose to attend the single game on Thursday, all three games on Friday or all three games on Saturday. There is a maximum of four adults who can purchase tickets for every 12 youth tickets purchased (e.g. a minimum of 12 youth tickets must be purchased per order, although there is no maximum number of youth tickets that can be purchased). NEW! OHSAA Football Playoffs Details

The 2024 OHSAA football playoffs will begin soon and feature many of the same elements as last year's tournament. Each region will qualify 16 teams to the playoffs (448 total teams; 64 teams per division); regional first-round and regional quarterfinal games will be hosted by the higher seeds, and regional semifinals, regional finals and state semifinals contests will be held at neutral sites. Like last year, all tournament contests prior to the state finals will be held on Fridays. The state finals will return to Tom Benson Hall of Fame Stadium in Canton Dec. 5-7. NEW! Reminder: State Law Requires All Coaches to Have PAP and to be Board-Approved

With OHSAA fall tournaments under way, administrators are reminded that state law REQUIRES individuals who direct, supervise or coach in your athletics program to have a valid **coaching or pupil activity permit**. That requirement is codified in OHSAA Bylaw 6-1-2 and applies to all coaches, whether paid or volunteer. School districts determine which staff members need to have a permit. In addition, OHSAA Bylaw 6-1-3 requires that all coaches be approved by the Board of Education or similar governing board in non-public schools.

OHSAA Tournament Tickets for School Administrators

Complimentary tickets for school administrators to attend OHSAA tournament events will work the same in 2024-25 as last year. All member school athletic administrators received an email in mid-September with their school comp code and instructions. This comp code allows schools to redeem tickets through HomeTown Ticketing, the OHSAA's official digital ticketing partner, when your teams are competing in OHSAA tournaments (three for individual sports; eight for team sports). The code you received is different from last year's code, but this code can be used throughout the 2024-25 school year.

Superintendents and principals who desire to attend a sectional or district tournament contest that does NOT involve your school can request a maximum of two complimentary tickets. This request needs to include the date, time and sport and should come from your official school email address. The request needs to be emailed to Claudia Markoff, OHSAA Customer Experience Manager (cmarkoff@ohsaa.org), a minimum of 24 hours before the event. About Coach Beyond: In 2021, the OHSAA and LiFEsports at The Ohio State University started collaborative work to change the landscape of coach training and education in Ohio. Ultimately, this partnership grew into a statewide initiative known as Coach Beyond. Over the last three years, a team of coaches, athletic administrators, OHSAA administrators and LiFEsports leaders set out to audit coaching education, conduct a statewide needs assessment, design and pilot trainings and ultimately train 15,000 coaches by June 2024. This goal has been reached, with 20,000-plus coaches receiving this training.
