Details and Schedule

The 2024 OHSAA football playoffs are down to 16 teams in each of the seven divisions (112 total teams) as we enter the regional semifinals this week. Friday's games along with the regional finals and state semifinals will be held at neutral sites, and all three of those rounds will be held on Fridays. The state finals will return to Tom Benson Hall of Fame Stadium in Canton Dec. 5-7. Here are the remaining football playoff dates:

The annual Ohio Association of Secondary School Administrator's (OASSA) Regional and State Cheer and Dance Championships will be held again this winter, and registration is now open. The fourth annual OASSA **7th/8th Grade Cheer State Championships** will be held Sunday, Dec. 8, 2024, at Big Walnut High School in Sunbury.

The 2025 OASSA **Dance Regional Qualifiers** are open to varsity cheerleading teams, with participants from Grades 9-12 only. All-star teams or middle school/junior high teams/members are NOT eligible to compete. In order to compete at the State of Ohio Dance Championship, you must attend and qualify at any ONE of these four Regional Qualifier events:

- Northeast: Friday, Jan, 10, 2025, Avon Lake High School
- Northwest: Saturday, Jan. 11, 2025, Sylvania Southview High School
- Central: Sunday, Jan. 12, 2025, Westerville North High School
- Southwest: Sunday, Jan. 12, 2025, Centerville High School

The 2025 OASSA **Dance STATE Championships** will be held Sunday, Jan. 26, 2025, at Heath High School. 7th & 8th grade dance teams do NOT have to attend a regional qualifier to qualify for Dance States.

2025 OASSA **Cheer Regional Qualifiers** are open to varsity cheerleading teams, with participants from Grades 9-12 only. All-star teams or middle school/junior high teams/members are NOT eligible to compete. In order to register to compete at the State of Ohio Cheer Championship, you must attend and qualify at any ONE of the five Regional Qualifier events:

- Central: Saturday, Jan. 25, 2025, Dublin Jerome High School
- Southeast: Friday, Jan. 31, 2025, Belmont Union Local High School
- Northwest: Saturday, Feb. 1, 2025, Whitehouse Anthony Wayne High School
- Northeast: Sunday, Feb. 2, 2025, Uniontown Lake High School
- Southwest: Sunday, Feb. 2, 202, at Camden Preble Shawnee High School

The 2025 OASSA Cheer State Championships will be held Friday, Feb. 21, 2025, at Dublin Jerome High School (Non-Tumbling); Saturday, Feb. 22, 2025, at Sunbury Big Walnut High School (D3, D4 & D6), and Sunday, Feb. 23, 2025, at Sunbury Big Walnut High School (D1, D2 & D5).

REMINDERS

OHSAA State Football Finals Tickets on Sale

All-session and indoor Stadium Club tickets, single-day packages and a team one-day discount package are currently on sale for the 2024 OHSAA State Football Finals that will be held Dec. 5-7 at Tom Benson Hall of Fame Stadium in Canton. Stadium Club all-session tickets include free access to tour the Pro Football Hall of Fame during the state championship weekend. The Pro Football Hall of Fame and Hall of Fame Village are located adjacent to the stadium. Tickets for the state football finals, and all OHSAA postseason tournament

contests in all sports, are available at www.OHSAA.org/tickets. Single-game ticket sales for the football state finals begin November 29.

ALL-SESSION STADIUM CLUB: All-session Stadium Club tickets are \$150 each and provide one ticket to all seven games in a theater style seat as well as access to the indoor club level of the press box containing its own concessions. Patrons with club access do not need to exit the stadium between games. The all-session Stadium Club package also includes access to tour the Pro Football Hall of Fame during the OHSAA Football State Championship weekend. A limited number of all-session Stadium Club tickets that include a parking pass are also available for \$210 each. These ticket holders will receive a parking hangtag for the weekend valid for a lot near the stadium.

ALL-SESSION GENERAL ADMISSION OR SINGLE-DAY PACKAGES: Other options include all-session general admission tickets that are \$90 for adults and \$60 for students, or three-game, single-day packages for Friday or Saturday games only that cost \$75 for Club Seating or \$40 for adults or \$30 for students for general admission seating.

TEAM ONE-DAY DISCOUNT PACKAGE: Additionally, a one-day discount package is available for football teams from elementary through high school. Teams can choose to attend the single game on Thursday, all three games on Friday or all three games on Saturday. There is a maximum of four adults who can purchase tickets for every 12 youth tickets purchased (e.g. a minimum of 12 youth tickets must be purchased per order, although there is no maximum number of youth tickets that can be purchased). The breakdown is as follows (**Note:** Purchasers will be directed to a Google page to complete information. A promo code will then be generated to complete the purchase):

About Coach Beyond: In 2021, the OHSAA and LiFEsports at The Ohio State University started collaborative work to change the landscape of coach training and education in Ohio. Ultimately, this partnership grew into a statewide initiative known as Coach Beyond. Over the last three years, a team of coaches, athletic administrators, OHSAA administrators and LiFEsports leaders set out to audit coaching education, conduct a statewide needs assessment, design and pilot trainings and ultimately train 15,000 coaches by June 2024. This goal has been reached, with 20,000-plus coaches receiving this training.
