Happy November! Hopefully you have had a great school year so far!

Thank you to everyone who participated in the OHSAA 7th and 8th Grade Cross Country Invitational on October 19! Invoices have been mailed and payment is due by November 30. PRE-SEASON PARENT MEETINGS – WINTER SPORTS

Don't forget to enter the date(s) of your Pre-Season Parent Meetings on your school's myOHSAA account. Meetings for grades 9-12 are to be recorded on the high school's myOHSAA account, while 7th and 8th grade meetings are recorded in the 7th & 8th grade school's myOHSAA account. If one meeting was held for all grades, the date must be recorded on <u>both</u> accounts.

Bylaw 3-1-4 requires the meeting date(s) to be entered in myOHSAA by a school administrator. Please login to your school's myOHSAA account today and click the Pre-Season Parent Meeting link to view or enter your meeting dates.

Schools that fail to enter their pre-season parent meetings are subject to a \$500 penalty per sport season. Schools that are subject to this penalty for the 2019 fall sports season will be invoiced on December 1. Therefore, make sure your meetings have been entered in myOHSAA to avoid this penalty.

REMINDER - BYLAW 1-6-4 EXCEPTION – MULTI-SCHOOL DISTRICTS

Member schools containing grades 7 and 8 may combine students from two or more schools within the school district/system to form one or more interscholastic team in a sport provided all requirements have been met. <u>Requests for permission to combine students from two or more schools in the same public district or non-public system must be submitted prior to the beginning of each sports season using the form located on the OHSAA's Eligibility page at ohsaa.org. The form must be completed by the superintendent or head of the public district or non-public system. The OHSAA sent superintendents instructions to apply for this exception in August. Please ensure your school is in compliance with Bylaw 1-6-4 and has received approval to combine students from more than one school if applicable. SPORT SPECIFIC UPDATES

Basketball – Just as a reminder, the official game ball adopted by the OHSAA for grades 7 & 8 is the **Rawlings CompOhio28.5CB**. This is required to be used for all regular season contests in grades 7 & 8. Do note, if your school is under a current contract (a contract executed before May 1, 2013, and still in term) for use of a ball other than Rawlings, the school may continue using that ball to honor its current contract. Further, any ball that is used in contests for grades 7 & 8 must have a circumference minimum of 28 1/2 inches to a maximum of 29 inches.
