- 7. Tournament Expansion Discussion We are going to have to communicate and work together to find more sites to host finals. What are travel distances going to look like? Not sure discussions are still in progress about how the divisions will be set up. DI and DII will not need as long to play their respective district tournaments. We will be combined with other districts. Smith, any thought given to pushing out how long schools host? At this time, we are still looking at only district finals at neutral sites. There are no firm plans on who and where will games be hosted. We will need to look at locations for mid-point hosting when districts are combined. Will we alternate between districts hosting? District boards will rely on the OHSAA sport administrators to take the lead on how the tournaments will be set up. Boards will need to contact AD's and schools seeking help in hosting. Moving schools between districts may not be an issue. There may be enough schools in each division to have their own regional qualifiers. The number of schools that are needed to have a regional qualifier is nine. Proposing to start with basketball and then taking that template, and farm it out to other sports. It will take all of us to secure sites and find host sites. Neutral sites will probably not come into play until District finals. Philosophy is to allow each District Board to run their district tournament at their discretion. We will need to wait and see what the numbers are going into next year. Discussions will be taking place moving forward. There will be more good than bad.
