4. Winter Sports Tournament Evaluations

- a. Basketball – Tom Stoughton – 18% girls return and 22% boys return if not many return the evaluations, then no news is good news. Most comments were positive coaches asking for a mid-level arena. Complaints concerning home site hosting, too many divisions, RPI and home site hosts. Hand out was given to the Board as a summary and commentary from Mr. Stoughton. ODU did the best job of hosting that they have ever done. Got to many of the venues to make sure that all sites feel that they were appreciated. There were no complaints on the floor for the first time being at the coliseum.
- b. Bowling – Jo Dimond – Summary report handed out to the Board. Looking at moving to two sectional days and taking the top 8 each day. Would like to thank Mr. Hayes for making financial reporting easier.
- c. Wrestling – Tom Rooney – Information will be determined by all boards meeting at the State baseball tournament. Waiting on sectional and district representation for next school year. Space continues to be an issue, moving the elimination rounds to Friday night, opened space for the weekend. Seeding changes were well received. Sites are being procured for next wrestling season. A lot of other

schools are looking to host that haven't sought hosting privileges in the past. Enrollment numbers will not come out until late summer. Assigned 11 sectionals and 6 districts. We are going deep into the officiating pool which gives them experience, but there tends to be a discrepancy between the top and lower rated officials.
