the regional tournament dates. Once the dates were finalized, it resulted in not finishing the district tournament during the week. ADs did not like the structure

of the pods in D1 and D2 schools. If the home team lost, then they still had to host and did not want to host. Lack of communication with the AD's resulted in some issues. Coaches had a lot of say in the structure of the tournament and did not communicate that with the AD's which resulted in some schools not happy. The coaches' only issue was the pitching constraints and not being able to use their #1 pitcher in the regional tournament. If we can come up with a format in D1 and D2 at a neutral site on the same day the Coaches and ADs would be happy, will need regional dates and site assignments earlier. With 19 district champions it is difficult to find enough sites to handle the load. Sites need to have turf and lights to pull it off. It would lend itself to a better tournament setting. Mark Spicer will no longer be the baseball assignor for the CDAB, did a good job but no longer wants to do the work, due to a new job. The board of directors will vote on regional sites in February and announce by March 2, 2026. Trying to avoid issues with the regional tournament tried to condense the district into a short time frame.
