

Protocols for Central District Sectional and District Bowling Tournaments

SPECTATORS

1. Due to COVID-19 spectators are restricted to ONE per bowler.
2. All tickets will be sold online PRIOR to the tournament and scanned for admission at the Main Entrance. Each school will receive their allotment of online tickets and be provided passcodes to distribute to their bowlers prior to the tournament. One passcode per bowler.
3. Spectators must enter through the main doors. Wear a mask/facial covering and maintain social distancing requirements at ALL times.
4. NO LADDERS OF ANY KIND WILL BE PERMITTED. Bleachers will be provided.
5. Spectators are required to wear a mask/facial covering at ALL times.

PARTICIPATING SCHOOLS

1. Bowlers and coaches are required to wear a mask/facial covering at ALL times. Exception is while bowler is on the approach or a bowler with an approved medical certificate for exemption.
2. Bowlers are restricted to using their own equipment. Balls and shoes (properly sanitized) will be available at the bowling center at no charge
3. Lane assignments for Sectional tournaments will be based on total pins from the 2020 Sectional tournaments for both Division I and II.
4. All Bowlers and coaches will enter through their assigned entrance based on lane assignments which will be sent to coaches in advance. Low end of the center will enter the south doors, high end will enter the north doors, and the bar entrance for those in the center. The coach will check-in and bowlers will go immediately to their assigned lane.
5. Coaches must submit the required COVID Assessment Form upon check-in to the tournament. This includes assessing your bowlers for COVID-19 symptoms including temperature, etc. This form is available on the bowling web page of OHSAA.org/CDAB.
6. Coaches are encouraged to complete the NFHS Covid-19 Course.
7. Sanitizing stations will be located throughout the bowling center.
8. Physical contact between bowlers and coaches should be limited.
9. Shared snacks are strongly discouraged – all food/beverages should be purchased from the bowling center.
10. Teams will remain on the same pair of lanes for all regular and Baker games.
11. Teams will be assigned in four-lane blocks with one pair between.
12. Team rosters/pass lists may not exceed 6 bowlers and one coach.
13. Schools may “live-stream” their matches.

DISTRICT QUALIFIERS

14. **Division I** – the top 16 teams/individuals will advance to the District based on total pin count after two days of competition. The **Division I District** event will be held on one day with two sessions: girls in the morning and boys in the afternoon.
15. **Division II** – the top 12 teams/individuals will advance to the District based on total pin count.
16. **Division II** District will be one day only, with everyone starting at the same time.
