Course:

The Hilliard Darby 5,000m course is a spectator friendly two loop course on grass at our North Athletic Fields. The course will be lined with two solid white lines. All miles will be well marked. Finish line starting positions will be randomly assigned by meet management. There will be a lead and rear cart for each race. Crowds will be controlled in and around the bike path crossings. Course is open for inspection Friday, October 23, 2020 from 8 AM to 10 AM.

All entries are due to www.baumspage.com by 8:00 PM on Tuesday, October 20, 2020. If entry window is missed a \$150.00 penalty fee will be assessed by OHSAA. Please make your entries early. Covid 19 Regulations & Expectations:

- Every spectator **MUST** conduct a symptom assessment prior to coming to the athletic event.
- Every spectator **MUST** have a ticket either printed or on their phone to scan.
- All spectators **MUST** be in masks before, during and after the contest.
- All spectators **MUST** practice social distancing and be at least 6 feet away from the nearest group of spectators.
- All spectators **MUST** enter and exit the event without gathering or congregating.
- All spectators **MUST** follow all signage, directions, and markings in place for the safety of the event.

All athletes must perform a symptom assessment prior to arriving at the venue and must wear masks the entire time except for when competing.

Drop-Off / Pick-up:

Buses may drop off in the lot near the tennis courts at Hilliard Darby High School north of the stadium. Parking attendants will direct bus traffic to the middle school parking lots. No buses should enter the Weston Trail neighborhood. Spectators need to park in the main lot near the stadium.

Race Day Packet:

Race day packets may be picked up at the finish line. All meet information, chips and results can be found at the trailer/tent near the finish line. Packets will not be distributed before Saturday.

Team Camps:

There are NO TENTS!!! If you would like to put a tarp down, that is okay. Camps are permitted on the practice football and surrounding fields on the north fields. Please make sure that camps do not interfere with the course and that sites are cleaned up when you leave. **Camps should not be made near the start / finish lines and or softball and baseball fields.** Please make sure that all runners are in masks and socially distanced when in their camp area.

Start line / Finish line:

Please arrive at the start line a minimum of fifteen minutes before each race begins, so that OHSAA officials may check in each team. There will be no finish cards in the finishing corral. Coaches and spectators should not be in the finish corral. Both the start and finish lines should be cleared of spectators. Spectators may stand behind the barriers, but they are not permitted on the lines or recovery area. Please coaches only!

Awards:

OHSAA Central District Athletic Board will provide 1st and 2nd place team trophies for each race contested. No individual awards will be issued. Team trophies may be picked up after results have been posted and announced. They will be located near the finish line at the announcers stand. No organized awards ceremony will be hosted.

Results / Scoring:

Timing First, LLC has been contracted to provide results and timing for all races. Please see their specific race day instructions. Failure to comply with these instructions will result in disqualification and or errors in results. Standard OHSAA scoring and displacement rules will be utilized. National Federation Rule 9-2-4 & 5 shall be used to break ties.

IPICO shoe tags are not disposable. All IPICO chips must be returned at the meet. Your athletic department will be charged for missing or damaged IPICO chips. Non-negotiable. Coaches are responsible for their return.

Results will be posted at the Wilcox Garage Building for viewing. They will be online at www.results.timingfirst.com and on Baumspage District Results Index later in the evening.

Uniforms/GPS Watches:

It is the responsibility of the coach and competitor to be sure that the athlete is dressed in the proper uniform for competition. OHSAA follows uniform rule 8-6 from the National Federations rule book. Cross Country uniforms must include a permanent number on the back of the uniform. GPS watches are not permitted.

Spectator Admission, Parking, Concessions / Restrooms:

Spectator admission will be charged for immediate family only. All tickets (\$8.00) will be purchases online for family members only. There will be NO tickets sold at the gate. Spectator parking will be located in the stadium parking lot of the Hilliard Darby Athletic Complex. Concessions will be located at Wilcox Garage Building on the North Athletic Fields. Restrooms are available at the Hilliard Darby Athletic Complex, and Port-a-Potties in the North Athletic Field Parking Lots.

T-Shirts:

A limited amount of T-shirts will be available with the OHSAA District logo provided by EA Graphics.

Recreational Equipment, Site Regulations, Pets:

No recreational sports equipment (footballs, frisbees, etc.) are permitted on the Hilliard Darby athletic fields. No drone usage is permitted without the expressed and written consent of Hilliard City Schools, Central District Athletic Board and the OHSAA. No pets are permitted on the Hilliard Darby Athletic Facilities.
