The OHSAA is utilizing the **OHSAA Golf** app powered by <u>iWanamaker</u> to provide live scoring for the sectional, district, and state tournaments. The OHSAA will continue to use <u>Baumspage</u> and the <u>Baumspage Golf App</u> to provide the traditional support for all sectional and district golf tournaments this fall. Coaches will submit rosters only in <u>iWanamaker</u> and confirm their names in the <u>OHSAA Directory</u>. The Baumspage staff will coordinate the import and transfer of data.

For the OHSAA Golf App:

- 1. All coaches and players will need to install the **OHSAA Golf** app on their smartphone and create an account.
- 2. To register, download and open the OHSAA Golf app from the <u>Apple App Store</u> or <u>Google</u> <u>Play Store</u>.
 - a) Click on **SIGN UP** at the opening screen.
 - b) Provide your Full Name, Email, and Password, then click **REGISTER AND GET STARTED**.
 - c) Enter the 4-digit code when you receive the confirmation email.
 - d) During the registration process you will be asked about your role
 - e) After creating your account, click Help to select Roster Management to view the video.
- 3. Parents and spectators wishing to follow the live scoring will need to install the OHSAA Golf app and purchase a ticket or pass.

Seeding: The seeding procedures are the same as previous years and will be completed using the **Central District** web site (<u>www.cdab.org</u>). Complete instructions were sent to the Athletic Director for distribution to the head coach last week.

**** NEW FOR 2024 roster submission: -

- 1. Coaches will need to create an account and submit rosters only in iWanamaker.
- 2. Please check your name in the <u>OHSAA Directory</u> and have your athletic director submit a correction ASAP if anything needs to be changed!

Roster Submission: Team and individual rosters must be submitted using iWanamaker.

- 1. Rosters must be submitted in seed order by 12:00 noon on Thursday the week before the tournament.
- 2. Changes to a team's line-up/roster can be made until the scheduled tee time for competition.

Online Entry Instructions:

- 1. Log in to your iWanamaker account | click Roster | edit the Seed numbers for your athletes.
 - Submit your roster in seed order before 12:00 noon on THursdayone week prior to the start of the tournament!
 - Select {your tournament} | click Edit Event | select {your team} | click the three dots … | Add Golfers | Select Athletes | Import | Make sure they are in seed order from 1 to 5!
 - Click <u>Sectional Entry-Screenshots</u> to view a flow chart with screenshots.
- 2. Tee times will be posted on the CDAB website on Monday, September 9th before 5:00 PM.

Spectators: Please advise parents

- 1. The price of admission for all sectional and district tournaments shall be \$8. All tickets must be purchased online at: <u>www.ohsaa.org/tickets</u>. Children under the age of five are provided complimentary admission.
- 2. Results will be posted live on the OHSAA Golf app by iWanamaker
 - a) Parents wishing to follow the live scoring will need to install the **OHSAA Golf** App on their smartphone or the **iWanamaker** app on their computer.
 - b) To view it they will need to purchase a ticket or pass.
 - c) Click the link OHSAA Golf App Event and Season Pass Information for details and pricing.
- 3. A limited number of carts may be available for spectators. Check with the pro shop. Carts must remain on the cart paths. No player may ride in a golf cart unless directed to do so by a Tournament Official.
- 4. Spectators walking the course must remain ½ hole ahead or behind the tee group they are following.

Greens Fee: Participating schools will not be charged green fees for competition rounds of play. Call pro shop for practice rounds and fees.

Rules:

- A. The Rules of Golf, as approved by the United States Golf Association and R & A, for Stroke Play and OHSAA tournament regulations shall prevail for all tournaments sponsored by the OHSAA.
- B. The Rules of Golf include an optional Local Rule that allows players to drop a ball with 2 penalty strokes in an area near where the ball was lost or estimated to go out of bounds. The Local Rule is not one of the 24 Rules of Golf; it is an optional Local Rule. This 2-stroke optional Local Rule may NOT be used at the OHSAA Sectional, District, or State tournaments.
- C. OHSAA Local Rule Sectional Tournaments Only Maximum allowable score of 12 strokes shall be used during OHSAA tournament play at the sectional level. Should a player reach 12 strokes on a hole, the player shall stop play on that hole and record their score as a 12. A player's score who has used the 12-stroke limit may still contribute their score to a team / individual score.

Coaches: Please review with the members of your team the information found in the <u>2024 OHSAA</u> <u>Tournament Regulations</u> and the <u>2024Tournament Manager's Manual</u> along with any other communications on Golf from the OHSAA.
