ENTRY PROCEDURE:

Tournament event files for the Sectional Tournaments are located on the OHSAA web site. Schools shall download the appropriate tournament event file based on their division: Boys Division I and Girls Division I. Eligible schools must submit the OHSAA Entry form ONLINE as well as verify that they have completed the Official OHSAA Eligibility Certificate. The swimming entries, which are submitted electronically, must be in possession of the Sectional Tournament Entry Chair on **Monday, February 7, 2022 at Noon.**

The diving entries must be submitted electronically via Hy-Tek TM AND via cleanentries.com.

Team Manager entries for diving are due to Sarah Tobin no later than Monday, February 7, 2022 at Noon. Cleanentries entries should be submitted to Phil Barr by Monday, February 14th at Noon.

Please note that all divers, both Division I Boys and Girls must be entered electronically in Hy-Tek with the Sectional Swimming Entries to be part of the meet entry file that is used to generate District and State Information. This is in addition to their online cleanentries.com entry.

Swimming Entry Procedures:

- Entries should be electronic on Hy-Tek Team Manager
- Electronic entries must be e-mailed to Sarah Tobin at ccsmeetentries@gmail.com by noon on Monday, February 7, 2022
- All coaches must be listed in your electronic entry or they will not be allowed on deck at Sectionals/Districts/Stages
- Each team is allowed up to 4 entries in each individual event
- Teams are allowed one relay per event
- Divers must be included on the Hy-Tek entry
- Divers must also submit their diving entry on-line in cleanentries.com
- Contestants are allowed to enter a maximum of four events (no more than two individuals).
- Being listed on a relay does not count as an event until the swimmer actually swims the event.
- All swimmers and divers entered in Sectionals must be listed on the OHSAA Eligibility Form, including relay-only swimmers
- **Entries are due NOON on Monday, February 7, 2022.** Entries may be turned in earlier as it would help with the clerical work.
- Be sure to include USA number for any USA swimmer.
- Psych Sheets shall not be posted until Wednesday, February 9, 2022 at 6:00 PM.

Diving Entry Procedures:

- Electronic dive entries must be e-mailed to Phil Barr at philbarr2@gmail.com by 9:00pm on Monday, February 14, 2022. District diving meet information is attached to the email.
- All coaches must be listed in your hytek electronic entry or they will not be allowed on deck at Districts
- Each team is allowed up to 4 entries in each individual event
- Divers must be included on the Hy-Tek entry due to Sarah Tobin on Monday, February 7, 2022
- Divers must also submit their diving entry on-line in cleanentries.com.
- All swimmers and divers entered in Sectionals must be listed on the OHSAA Eligibility Form, including relay-only swimmers
- Divers enter an 11 dive score earned at a competition. Coaches may be asked to verify these scores.
- Entries are due 9:00 pm on Monday, February 14, 2022. Entries may be turned in earlier.

SWIMMING COMPETITION:

- Swimmers are not permitted in the area immediately behind the starting block area unless they are competing in the event in the water or the event on call. Please keep this area as clear as possible for the timers and officials
- Coaches and swimmers need to remain quiet at the start
- Only swimmers entered in the meet, coaches, meet workers, and officials are permitted on the deck. It will be up to coaches to monitor swimmers
- All teams/swimmers entered in the meet must sit on the pool deck or in the south stands by the score board
- The gym will be open/set up for rub down tables and for swimmers to relax
- Coaches are responsible for seeing their team areas and locker rooms are left clean at the end of the meet

DECK CREDENTIALS:

All buses should enter the driveway off Harrison Ave and drop off swimmers and coaches off at door 3N.

Swimmers will NOT be permitted to enter through the main entrance (Door 1N). Coaches should enter with their team through these door 3N to the gym.

- Athletes will be checked in by CCS staff upon arrival. Please have swimmers line up alphabetically so check in can run smoothly.
- Wristbands must be worn by coaches to be permitted on deck and for admittance into hospitality
- Only volunteers wearing wristbands will be permitted on deck during the meet
- Swimmers entered in the meet will NOT be permitted to sit in the stands

COACHES' MEETING:

There will be a coaches meeting prior to the start of the swimming competition if needed.

RELAY CARDS:

Coaches will be given a MM print out of relays with the entered relay names. Please indicate the four swimmers who will swim each relay by numbering the swimmers. Relay sheets need to be signed and turned into the announcers/scores table by 8:00 am.

LOCKERS:

- The girls and boys locker rooms will be available for the girls and boys, respectively
- We are not responsible for personal belongings

AWARDS:

There are no awards for this meet.

GOVERNING RULES:

The meet will be conducted under the OHSAA 2022 Boys and Girls Swimming and Diving Tournaments rules and regulations located on <https://www.ohsaa.org/sports/swimming>. The official coach or school representative must be with his/her swimmers or divers at all times. This includes the entire warm-up period and all competition. If it is determined that the coach or representative is not in attendance at any time, all competitors from the school will be disqualified from further competition. UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT PENALTY:

During participation in OHSAA tournaments, any student or coach ejected for unsportsmanlike conduct shall be ineligible for the remainder of that day as well as for all contests in swimming and diving until the two regular season/tournament contests are competed at the same level as the ejection. Individuals ejected for unsportsmanlike conduct shall be reported to the OHSAA Commissioner by the tournament manager. The Commissioner will investigate the situation and may impose additional penalties in accordance with Bylaw 11 if the situation warrants. Participation in an athletic contest is a privilege. Each individual is expected to conduct himself or herself in an exemplary manner while participating.

PARKING:

Parking is free. Please park in the staff and student lot off Blake Ave and 17th Street. Spectators may not park on Harrison Avenue.

Buses will park in the far back student lot. Buses will not be permitted to park on Harrison Ave along the fence or along the school sidewalk.

Spectators should enter through door 1N located under the bridge towards the east side of the building.

RULES REGARDING USE OF THE FACILITY:

- **Covid – All individuals must wear a mask in the facility including all swimmers. Swimmers must wear their masks unless they are actively swimming.**
- Per State Health Department guidelines, there will be **NO SHAVING** in the Building.
- NO glass containers on the pool deck or in the locker rooms. NO glass containers are permitted in the facility.
- There is no insurance coverage for property damage. Any damage at the site by participants, including cost of repair, will be assessed to the responsible school. Schools and the president of the NEDAB will be notified the next working day of any damage caused by participants.
- Coaches are responsible for maintaining cleanliness of their deck and locker room areas to be sure they are free of food and other debris.
- No helium balloons are permitted in the facility.
- Rubdowns are to be done only in the gym on the tarps.
- No hand paddles are permitted in the pool.
- Taping of signs to painted surfaces will not be permitted.
- Per State Association orders, the facility will be closed following the last swimming event. There will be no celebrations in the facility after the meet.

USA OBSERVATION:

This meet will be USA observed; therefore, all USA Swimming registered athletes times will be uploaded to SWIMS. Please make sure you have USA Swimming ID # in the database to insure that the times are uploaded. If you are unsure, please email Sarah Tobin.

PARA ATHLETE COACHES:

If you have a Para 1 or Para 2 athlete, you MUST first of all complete the verification form which can be found on the OHSAA website. The form is labeled the [Para Swimming Verification Form](#) & [Entry Form](#) and must be returned to the OHSAA office by February 7, 2022 at 12:00 Noon, the entry deadline for all athletes who will compete in the post-season tournaments. All Para athletes must be entered in sectionals in the correct event and the correct Para category. The Para events offered are the 50 Free Girls, event numbers 145 (Para 1) and 245 (Para 2), the 50 Free Boys, event numbers 165 (Para 1) and 265 (Para 2), the 100 Back Girls, event numbers 150 (Para 1) and 250 (Para 2), and the 100 Back Boys, event numbers 170

(Para 1) and 270 (Para 2). The Para events will only be competed in the DI State Tournament in 2022. Para athletes will receive awards, but the Para events will not be scored.

ALL COACHES:

It is your responsibility to be versed in the rules and regulations, including the changes and the highlighted areas of the 2021-2022 Swimming and Diving Rules and Regulations. Please read carefully all the highlighted areas in the following document on the OHSAA website, 2021-22 OHSAA Tournament Regulations. Direct any questions you have about any rule or regulation to your Sectional Meet Manager or District Meet Manager for clarification.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Ties up to 12th place will be resolved in one of three ways: a swim-off, a toss of a coin, or one swimmer may defer to the other swimmer.

One 15-minute break will occur after the 50 Freestyle to be consistent with the District and State Tournament format. There shall be a minimum 15-minute time-period from the start of consecutive same gender events in the postseason tournament.

Coaches should have all medical forms with you for all of your swimmers and divers during completion. For any and all swimmers using the kinesis/medical tape, you must have the properly signed documentation. It would be advisable to give the referee a copy of the slip and you can keep the original for use at the next level of competition.
