## **RULES & REGULATIONS**

## PLAYER(S) / COACHES REGISTRATION

All players and coaches must report to the Tournament Table PRIOR to warming up on the courts

The success of any tournament depends on the coaches. The team is your responsibility and exhibits the manners and sportsmanship you have instilled in them to represent your school. The coaches, by enforcing the high standards of conduct and sportsmanship, eliminate any possibility of default. This tournament is too important to each athlete to have any match jeopardized because he or she did not know the rules.

### **VERY IMPORTANT ITEMS (PLEASE READ CAREFULLY)**

- 1. Players and Coaches MUST report to the tournament table PRIOR to warming up.
- 2. School Vans must be parked in the bottom parking lot, and school buses across the street at the hotels. See the diagram.
- 3. Follow all rules outlined in the Girls Coaches Manual. Be familiar with the publication.
- 4. Make sure players are in proper attire.
- 5. There will be a minimum of 45 minutes between matches.
- 6. Only ONE coach can be on the court during play. Please stay off the playing surface except on changeovers and between sets. Coaches do not flip the scorecards; allow that to the players.
- 7. Control your spectators! Make sure they are following the rules, and they are staying out of the Athletic Club (if nice day), especially restaurant and lobby area. Failure to stay out of there could result the removal from the facility and tournament.
- 8. Teams, please set up outside, with tents, if nice weather. **PLAYERS MUST STAY OUTSIDE** between matches. **NO** hanging out inside, unless they are in the Fieldhouse area. If inclement weather, all players, coaches and spectators must be in the Fieldhouse.
- 9. All tickets are ONLINE. Adults: \$10 Students: \$5.
- 10. Courts open for warm-up at 7:15am (outdoor only, unless rain then indoor courts open at 7:30).
