ENTRIES PROCEDURES:

- Entries should be electronic on Hy-Tek Team Manager
- Electronic entries must be e-mailed to Mike McGee at <u>mmcgee0225@aol.com</u> by noon on Monday, February 8, 2021
- All coaches must be listed in your electronic entry or they will not be allowed on deck at Districts
- You must use the correct school code. A list of those codes is included in this packet. Please make sure yours is correct in the Hy-Tek program
- Each team is allowed up to 4 entries in each individual event
- Teams are allowed one relay per event
- Contestants are allowed to enter a maximum of four events (no more than two individuals).
- There will not be any relay only swimmers allowed due to space limitations. You must use the swimmers you have entered in the Meet to fill out all of your relay spots. NO Exceptions!
- Being listed on a relay does not count as an event until the swimmer actually swims the event.
- Divers enter a six-dive score
- Entries are due NOON on Monday, February 8, 2021. Entries may be turned in earlier as it would help with the clerical work. You will receive a confirmation email once the Meet Manager has received your entries and entered into Meet Manager.
- During the meet there will be **NO SUBSTITUTIONS FOR ANY REASON.** Any team attempting a substitution will have that/those swimmers disqualified, according to OHSAA rules.
- Be sure to include USA number for any USA swimmer.

DIVING COMPETITION: See the attached diving information page about site, dates and other important information. **Diving entries** must be submitted in two forms: 1) in eDive to the Diving Site Manager at either the Sectional or District level AND 2) in Hy-Tek with the swimming entries to the respective Sectional Meet Manager.

- Divers must submit their diving entry on-line in edive®. Go to http://www.edive.info/index.htm for information about this electronic program. And those edive diving entries must be submitted to Phil Barr (philbarr2@gmail.com) by noon on Sunday, February 7, 2021 (DI ONLY!)
- Divers enter a six-dive score.

PLEASE NOTE THAT ALL DIVERS, DIVISION I AND II, GIRLS AND BOYS BOTH, MUST BE ENTERED ELECTRONICALLY IN HY-TEK WITH THE SECTIONAL SWIMMING ENTRIES TO BE A PART OF THE MEET ENTRY FILE THAT IS USED TO GENERATE DISTRICT AND STATE DIVING INFORMATION. THIS IS IN ADDITION TO THE E-DIVE ENTRY PROCEDURE.

PARA SWIMMING:

Para Athlete Coaches: Please read the document entitled Para Athlete Entry Instructions for 2021 Para Athlete Competition which will be posted on the OHSAA.org website. Make sure to complete the Para Athlete verification form also found on the OHSAA.org swimming link. Note specific dates for submitting the verification form and how to enter your para swimmers.

COACHES:

Coaches: please read in the section entitled ENTRIES (4) the bolded NOTE entry in the 2021 REGULATIONS BOYS AND GIRLS SWIMMING AND DIVING TOURNAMENTS at <u>www.ohsaa.org</u>.

DECK CREDENTIALS: Wristbands will be distributed to board approved coaches from each school. They **MUST** be displayed at all times or else you will be asked to leave the facility. All swimmers in the meet will be stamped or marked when entering. Any swimmer not participating in the meet will **NOT** be permitted in the facility due to strict social distancing and capacity guidelines.

UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT PENALTY: During participation in OHSAA tournaments, any student or coach ejected for unsportsmanlike conduct shall be ineligible for the remainder of that day as well as for all contests in swimming and diving until the two-regular season/tournament contests are competed at the same level as the ejection. Individuals ejected for unsportsmanlike conduct shall be reported to the OHSAA Commissioner by the tournament manager. The Commissioner will investigate the situation and may impose additional penalties in accordance with Bylaw 11 if the situation warrants. Participation in an athletic contest is a privilege. Each individual is expected to conduct himself or herself in an exemplary manner while participating.

<u>GOVERNING RULES</u>: The meet will be conducted under the OHSAA 2021 Boys and Girls Swimming and Diving Tournaments rules and regulations located on <u>https://www.OHSAA.org</u>. The official coach or school representative must be with his/her swimmers or divers at all times. This includes the entire warm-up period and all competition. If it is determined that the coach or representative is not in attendance at any time, all competitors from the school will be disqualified from further competition.

SWIM COACHES AND ATHLETE CHECK-IN:

Relay cards / Heat Sheets / Scratch sheet will be available in your coaches' packet that you will receive as you check in prior to locker room and pool deck access.

- Please line up your swimmers participating in the meet in alphabetical order (boys and girls mixed together).
- Coach will receive a wristband that must be worn at all times. Athletes will be marked orange (seated on deck) or green (seated in stands). Signs will be on the locker room doors explaining which teams will be using which one.

MEDICAL FORMS

- Coaches should have all medical forms with you for all of your swimmers and divers during competition. For any and all
 swimmers using the kinesis/medical tape, you must have the properly signed documentation to present at all levels of
 regular and post-season competition.
- Each coach will need to sign a Covid Verification form that all swimmers and staff from your school have been checked for covid signs.

TEAM SEATING ASSIGNMENT

All teams have designated bleachers that their team needs to report to. Deck / Stands chart of the location will be distributed with the psych sheet.

HOSPITALITY

A hospitality room available for coaches/officials/volunteers only in the middle office area. It will be limited to pre-packaged items and variety of beverages.

USA OBSERVATION:

This meet will be USA observed; therefore, all USA Swimming registered athletes' times will be uploaded to SWIMS. Please make sure you have USA Swimming ID # in the database to ensure that the times are uploaded. If you are unsure, please email Sarah Tobin.

THE 2021 SWIMMING AND DIVING SECTIONAL MEET SCHEDULE At Ellen Shapiro Natatorium, Wooster High School

COVID GUIDELINES & PROTOCOL: Attached to this information is a list of guidelines and protocol that must be followed while participating at Sectionals. Those refusing to follow the protocol will be asked to leave the facility.

RULES REGARDING USE OF THE FACILITY

- 1. All policies & procedures, as posted via signage around the pool deck area should be used as a reference point.
- 2. There is no insurance coverage for property damage. Any damage at the site by participants, including cost of repair, will be assessed to the responsible school. Schools and the president of the NEDAB will be notified the next working day of any damage caused by participants.
- 3. Coaches are responsible for maintaining cleanliness of their deck and locker room areas to be sure they are free of food and other debris.
- 4. No body painting will be allowed in any available locker room or restroom located in the Wooster YMCA facility.
- 5. Per State Association orders, the facility will be closed following the last swimming event. There will be no celebrations in the facility after the meet.
- 6. No noise makers (horns, bells, whistles, sirens, drums, etc.) will be allowed during the meet. Including music playing except what is being played over the PA system.
- 7. No rub-downs allowed in the facility.
- 8. No shaving in any available locker rooms or restrooms located throughout the Wooster YMCA and Wooster High School facility.
- 9. Taping of signs to painted surfaces will not be permitted.
- 10. Absolutely no glass containers allowed on the pool deck or in the stands.

OFFICIALS POINT OF INTEREST

- A. Difference between a scratch and a declared false start (DFS). A scratch will remove a swimmer from the entire meet; a DFS will remove that swimmer from a particular event. It still counts as an event swum. The coach MUST tell the referee or starter of any DFS PRIOR to that event. Being a championship meet, any swimmer missing his or her event will be disqualified from further competition for the rest of the meet. Any results prior to the missed event will still be counted.
- B. The whistle starting commands will be used.
- C. There will be dual confirmation on all false starts and relay takeoffs.
- D. Swimmers are allowed to wear one (1) suit during competition. Any school logo on suits shall not exceed 9 square inches.
- E. Suits cannot go below the top of the kneecap for both boys and girls.
- F. Only one (1) manufacturer's logo on suits and caps.
- G. Make sure that all your swimmers have legal caps. The caps must be team or plain cap. No club teams or college caps are allowed. A swimmer is allowed to wear two caps.
- H. There will be four-five officials. The referees and starters will remain at their positions throughout. The remaining officials may rotate their positions.

DURING THE MEET

- First feet entry in both the deep and shallow end during the warm-up periods.
- No coaches are allowed behind the blocks with their swimmers once the competition begins.
- Coaches need to bring their own person chair to set up along the non-bulkhead side of the pool. There will be "X" to mark where each coach can set up. This area and the area behind the coaches must be swimmer free throughout the meet.
- No coaches or swimmers are allowed to be on the scorer's table platform. MEET PERSONNELL ONLY!

INCLEMENT WEATHER

Teams/Schools should plan on the meet proceeding as scheduled on the timeline outlined unless Wooster City Schools are closed. Wooster City Schools reserves the right to postpone &/or reschedule if weather situation dictates those measures. If any postponement or rescheduling were to occur, information would be passed along to teams/schools as soon as possible.

COACHES' MEETING AND RELAY CARDS: There will be no coaches meeting at the meet. There is a possibility of having a Google Meet meeting before the entries are due to ask any questions you do not understand from this information.

The following guidelines (protocol) was put together on the recommendations of the Ohio & Local Dept. of Health, Ohio Governor's Office, OHSAA, and NFHS.

PRE-MEET PROTOCOL

- Swimmers & Coaches must wear masks entering and exiting the facility.
- Participants from teams should arrive at the contest facility dressed in partial or full uniform and should plan to leave the contest facility in partial or full uniforms.
- Teams must remain in their designated area when not competing throughout the meet.
- Participants need to bring their own water bottles, meet items, and equipment. No sharing.
- Social Distancing will be enforced. No mixing of teams. Stay in designated area.
- All swimmers will have a symptom assessment before each meet. Anyone experiencing symptoms must stay home.
- Swimmers will need to bring a Ziploc bag or tub to put their mask in after they take it off for their event.
- Swimmers seated in the spectator stands will not be allowed in the deck area where teams are located, and deck area teams will not be allowed to be in the spectator stands. (except to warm-up and cool down)

LOCKER ROOM PROTOCOL

- Teams labeled green only use the green designated locker rooms, and teams labeled orange only use the orange designated locker rooms. Signs will be posted on both entrances to the locker rooms.
- No showering.
- Masks must be worn and please social distance.
- Locker rooms should only be used to use the restroom and put on fast skin suits.

WARM-UP PROTOCOL

- During warm-ups, there will be a limit number of swimmers per lane (4)
- One team per lane.
- Starts need to be included during your warm up time.
- Social Distancing behind the blocks.
- Please enter the pool on the south side (by diving board) end of the pool to begin your warm ups.
- At the end of your session please exit to go back to your designated area at the block end.

MEET PROTOCOL

- Only swimmers in the event that is up next can be behind the block. Example: 100 free girl swimmer in that lane, than 6 ft back boy swimmer. On deck area close to the blocks will be set up for each team at opposite ends of the starting area. Social Distance.
- No sitting or standing behind the blocks along the wall of windows or to cheer.
- No cheering from behind the lanes. Must remain clear.
- Swimmers seated in the spectator stands will not be allowed in the deck area where teams are located, and deck area teams will not be allowed to be in the spectator stands.
- No congregating of swimmers around the coach at the end of the event. Swimmer(s) must return to their assigned area.
- Athletes will need to follow the "flow of traffic" markings when entering and exiting the block area.
- Teams seated in the spectator area (green area) will enter the pool deck through the door on the south side of the stands, and will return to their seating assignment by the stairs behind the blocks (those stairs will only be for going into the spectator area, not to enter the deck).
- No one except the following can be on the scorer's platform: timing, computer, trainer, announcer.
- At the end of completion all in attendance will be asked to leave immediately. No congregating.

COACHES:

- Coaches must wear masks at all times.
- Coach is responsible for making sure their athletes are following all guidelines (wearing masks when not competing, social distancing, staying in their designated area when not competing, and follow all traffic patterns.
- Swimmers cannot congregate by the coach at any time while the coach is in the designated coach's area. There is no room to social distance from others.
- Coaches must supply their own chair to sit on in the coach's area.
- All coaches will be given a wristband upon entrance that they must wear.
- We asked that you check on your athletes throughout the meet to make sure all protocol is being followed. COVID-19 Marshal's will be around to enforce the rules also, so we ask that the athletes respect their request if approached.

MEET PERSONNEL:

- Personnel makes up of the following: 9 timers, 6 officials, Timing System Operator, Announcer, Computer Operator, 3 lifeguards, 3 COVID-19 marshals, trainer
- Personnel must wear a mask at all time, and the proper way over both mouth and nose.
- Must socially distance from the athletes and all others.
- There will be one timer per lane.
- Any personnel that violate these guidelines will be asked to leave the facility.

All the guidelines are to make sure that everyone in attendance has a safe environment, and the precaution if there is a COVID-19 case we can contact trace.

This map is to help you understand the traffic flow for the Sectional Swim Meets. (Thursday and Friday school is In session so please be vigilant to their busing procedures, especially in the drop off area)

The yellow arrows map out where the buses can go to drop off the athletes / coaches. It is a one-way drive. After the athletes are dropped off, the buses will have to go back around and park in the lot to the east of the high school.

The red arrows will be where the athletes / coaches will exit the facility and get picked up after the conclusion of the meet.



GREEN ARROWS represent the flow of athletes seated in the spectator stands to enter and exit the starting area of the pool. **ORANGE ARROWS** represent the flow of athletes seated on the deck to enter and exit the starting area of the pool.
