Swimming Spectators - Ticket Information

- 1. 2020 District Swimming Division specific ticket sales will be available for purchase online by coaches or spectators. The allotted number per school will be based on the number of initial swimming qualifiers posted Sunday 2/9/20 on the NWDAB website. 2 tickets per qualifier.
- 2. Instructions for Head Coaches to obtain their codes to order tickets will be posted on NWDAB website in January.
- 3. Division 2 spectator tickets on sale: Monday 2/10/20 at 12:00pm through Tuesday 2/11/20 at 12:00pm. Division 1 spectator tickets on sale: Tuesday 2/11/20 at 12:00pm through Wednesday 2/12/20 at 12:00pm. General admission online tickets on sale for both divisions to the general public: Thursday 2/13/20 at 9:00am through the conclusion of that meet or when sold out. If not sold out, tickets will also be available at the door.
- 4. General admission will be limited to two (2) tickets per transaction (adult/senior/student) for \$7+cc swipe fee. The number of tickets available will be posted at the online ticket sales site after Division pre-sale is over.
- 5. Once tickets are purchased for either Division, there are <u>no refunds</u> for unused tickets or errors in purchasing.
- 6. Once a ticket is scanned, it becomes INVALID! Do not try to use it again, you will not be granted entry.
- 7. All tickets, beginning with Coaches presale tickets, will be placed in Group(s) A, B, C & D (350 tickets per group), and all tickets will be grouped on a first-come, first-serve basis based on the time of purchase.
 - Group A ► Group line-up location established @ 1:40 PM; Group A Entry begins @ 2:00 PM
 - Group B ► Group line-up location established @ 1:40 PM; Group B Entry begins after Group A has entered. (Look for Group B sign)
 - Group C ► Group line-up location established @ 1:40 PM; Group C Entry begins after Group B has entered. (Look for Group C sign)
 - Group D ► Group line-up location established @ 1:40 PM; Group D Entry begins after Group C has entered. (Look for Group D sign)

Note: The group line-up location for each group will be near the main BGSU Student Recreation Center entrance and it will be managed by authorized university staff. **Pre-Sale ticket holders should not arrive earlier than 1:40 PM, and form a line based on ticket number within that Group.**

- 8. Spectators with special passes (NWDAB, Administrator, etc.) will not be allowed early entry into the facility or permitted entry prior to those with purchased tickets.
- 9. No restrooms will be available in the SRC until the doors open at 2:00pm.
- 10. Once inside the SRC, follow posted directions. There will be a table set up where your printed or digital ticket will be scanned. Hands will be marked if you are going to temporarily leave the building.
- 11. Spectators may not bring chairs, coolers or other large extended stay objects or equipment into the Rec Center.
- 12. Saving seats in the bleachers is NOT permitted!

- 13. Heat sheets (\$5) will be sold prior to the doors opening (weather permitting) and will also be sold inside at the admissions table or concessions.
- 14. Personal belongings in the bleacher area are to be stored on your lap or at your feet. There will be a coat check (for donation) at the desk area in the climbing wall room. Neither the meet host nor BGSU are responsible for any items left at the conclusion of the competition. During the competition, overflow lounge space/seating is available on basketball court #1 (there are no sightlines to the pool).
- 15. The workout areas of the student rec center are off limits unless you purchase a day pass.
