Eligibility: All participants must be eligible under the rules of the OHSAA

Classification: Boys Division II and Girls Division II

Entries: Sectional entries (include divers) must be received by the District Meet Manager by 5:00pm, Sunday, February 2, 2020. All entries must be submitted electronically via email using Hy-Tek Team Manager software. Follow the entry instructions posted on the OHSAA website. An event file is also posted on the OHSAA website.

Psych Sheets will not be posted until Wednesday, February 5, 2020 at 6:00pm.

Entry times must be indicated for the events. No changes in times can be made after the entry deadline.

Tournament Entry Procedure: When you are ready to submit your team entries for sectionals via email to the Northwest District Meet Manager (NOT the sectional site manager), please format the subject line in your email with the following information: Your official school code, D1/D2, NW Sectional Entries.

It will look like this:

There is NO team scoring at the sectional level.

200 yard Medley Relay

200 yard Freestyle

200 yard Individual Medley

50 yard Freestyle

**15 minute break

100 yard Butterfly

100 yard Freestyle

500 yard Freestyle

200 yard Freestyle Relay

100 yard Backstroke

100 yard Breaststroke

400 yard Freestyle Relay

(There is NO scheduled break after 100 breaststroke)

Site Specific Information:

- Doors open to the spectators' observation deck and Special Needs Area at 10:00 a.m. Please be respectful of the handicap and senior citizens' bleachers. This area is reserved for them.
- Saving seats in the observation deck and in the bleachers is NOT permitted!
- Spectators may not bring chairs, coolers or other large, extended stay objects or equipment into the YMCA facility.
- Blankets are not permitted into the spectator area and neither the meet host nor the Lima YMCA is responsible for any items left, lost, or stolen.
- Spectators are to park in the lot across the street or caddy corner to the YMCA main parking lots. Please see the map.
- Bring locks for lockers. Locker space is limited. Please have swimmers watch their belongings.
- Swimmers are to use rear stairs nearest the gymnasium to enter and leave the pool area.
- Swimmers are restricted to the locker room, gymnasium, pool area, and concessions on 2nd floor. Swimmers are not to be in other areas of the YMCA or the observation deck.
- Food and drinks are restricted to the concession area.
- Individual teams are responsible to pick up debris in their area.
- School buses and school vans are to park in the parking lot Northwest to the YMCA. Please see map.
- Per OHSAA Rules, NO SHAVING at the meet facility. Any athlete found to be in violation will be ejected from the meet.
