**Entries:** Sectional entries (include divers) must be received by the District Meet Manager by 5:00pm, Sunday, February 2, 2020. All entries must be submitted electronically via email using Hy-Tek Team Manager software. Follow the entry instructions posted on the OHSAA website. An event file is also posted on the OHSAA website.

Psych Sheets will not be posted until Wednesday, February 5, 2020 at 6:00pm.

Entry times must be indicated for the events. No changes in times can be made after the entry deadline.

**Tournament Entry Procedure:** When you are ready to submit your team entries for sectionals via email to the Northwest District Meet Manager (NOT the sectional site manager), please format the subject line in your email with the following information: Your official school code, D1/D2, NW Sectional Entries.

100 yard Breaststroke

400 yard Freestyle Relay

(There is NO scheduled break after 100 breaststroke)

### Site Specific Information:

- Bring locks for lockers. Locker space is limited. Please have swimmers secure their belongings.
- Teams will utilize the auxiliary gym to store their team bags and non-competitive equipment. Athletes will not be permitted to keep these items on deck.
- Individual teams are responsible to pick up debris in their area.
- There will be hospitality for coaches and officials in the teachers' lounge off the cafeteria.
- There will be concessions.
- The shallow end of the pool will be open throughout the meet. One hand on deck to enter the pool - there is NO diving into the shallow end of the pool.
