TIME SCHEDULE: Saturday, Division III. Boys. 9:00 am. Girls, 10:00 am
Saturday. Division II. Boys. 12:00 pm. Girls. 1:00 pm
Saturday, Division I. Boys. 3:00 pm. Girls, 4:00 pm

BUS DROP OFF: North side of stadium

BUS PARKING: Saturday: at Troy Junior High

VAN PARKING: In North stadium lot

RV PARKING: ONLY in lot North of swimming pool

PACKET PICKUP: Northwest corner of stadium @ white tent
Coaches must sign verification form to receive packet

CLERK CHECK-IN. Due to Covid 19, coaches need to check their team in with the clerks for uniform inspection. The clerks will be in a tent behind the scoreboard. Please do this 30-60 minutes before your race.

STARTING LINE: Due to Covid 19, each team or individuals will line up SINGLE FILE 6' apart in their box. This will be marked for each runner. When given the signal, runners will move to the starting line for the gun and start of race. This starting procedure was approved by the OHSAA

PASSES: TEAMS-10 passes per team, for athletes and coaches.
INDIVIDUALS-one (1) per athlete and one (1) for coach.

PARKING: Cars only at Hobart Arena. Handicap parking in SE corner of Hobart.

COURSE INSPECTION: The course is always open and will be roughed in the week prior.
Restrooms close at 5:00 pm week days.

RESTROOMS: Restrooms are available to athletes on the North side of the stadium on Saturday.

CAMPS: West of stadium behind the scoreboard.

TICKETS: PURCHASED ONLINE ONLY! NO tickets will be sold at the gate.
Each competing athlete and one (1) coach will be permitted to purchase four (4) tickets. (See your coach for info.) Tickets are \$10.00

HOBART ARENA: (Due to other events, your athletes are NOT permitted to enter.)

STARTING BOXES: Posted on Finishtiming.com and baumspage.com

AWARDS: There will be NO AWARDS PRESENTATION. Coaches can pick up awards at the ticket booth on the South side of the stadium. Stay outside of fence. See Bob Karl.

FIRST AID: Will be available on the course and at the chute. An ambulance will transport to Upper Valley Medical Center on North 25A.

DRONES: Not permitted on tournament sites.
