TEAM DROP OFF: In Front of Troy Memorial Stadium

BUS PARKING: Saturday: at Troy Junior High and Troy High School

VAN PARKING: In North stadium lot

RV PARKING: ONLY in lot North of swimming pool

PACKET PICKUP: Northwest corner of stadium @ white tent near Team drop off location
Coaches must sign verification form to receive packet

CLERK CHECK-IN. Coaches need to check their team in with the clerks for uniform inspection.
Please do this 30 minutes before your race at the starting line.

PASSES: Per OHSAA guidelines (NO Exceptions)
Coaches & Athletes must wear wristband for entry
TEAMS-10 passes per team, for athletes and coaches.
INDIVIDUALS-one (1) per athlete and one (1) for coach.
Extras will need to purchase a ticket.

PARKING: Cars only at Hobart Arena **NO TEAM BUSES**. Handicap parking in SE corner of Hobart.

COURSE INSPECTION: The course is always open and will be roughed in the week prior.
Restrooms close at 5:00 pm week days.

RESTROOMS: Restrooms are available on both sides of the stadium on Saturday.

CAMPS: West of stadium behind the scoreboard.

TICKETS: PURCHASED ONLINE ONLY! NO CASH SALES FOR TICKETS WILL BE SOLD AT THE GATE.
Tickets are \$12.00 (adult); \$9.00 (student) online and can be purchased at: Hometown Ticketing or the OHSAA ticket site (<https://www.OHSAA.org/tickets>)

HOBART ARENA: **NO TEAM CAMPS PERMITTED** (Due to other events, your athletes are NOT permitted to enter.)

AWARDS: Awards will be presented at the conclusion of each divisional race (Check time schedule). Awards will be presented inside the stadium. Qualifying athletes should enter the track at the east end of the bleachers. NO SPECTATORS ON THE TRACK. Spectators should remain in the bleachers on the south side of the track.

FIRST AID: Athletic Trainers will be available on the course and at the chute. An ambulance will transport to Kettering Hospital or Upper Valley Medical Center.

DRONES: Not permitted on tournament sites.
