# **Entry and Parking:**

## Buses and designated School Vans should enter the complex off of Cox Road!

- Meet personnel will direct school transportation to the drop off area.
- Athletes, Coaches, equipment should be dropped off at the designated site.
- Buses/ Vans will be directed to the back of the property after drop off.
- Buses/ Vans will be asked to exit onto Butler Warren and circle around the block to the entrance on Cox Road to pick up teams/equipment.
- All traffic will exit the complex and turn right onto Butler-Warren Rd.

#### There are two entrances to the VOA Complex for spectators:

- #1 off of Cox Road and #2 off of Butler Warren Road.
- There will **NOT** be a charge for parking.
- Handicapped Parking will be available with placard.
- All traffic will exit the complex and turn right onto Butler-Warren Rd.

#### **Team and Individual Qualifiers:**

# **DII Girls, 2 Races:**

- Race A, 13 Teams, 7 Teams qualify and 14 additional qualifiers not on a team.
- Race B, 12 Teams, 6 Teams qualify and 12 additional qualifiers not on a team.
- \*\*\*If we have one team drop, Race A = 13 and Race B = 11
- \*\*\*If additional teams drop adjustments will be made, but will not be changed after race assignments are made on October 5<sup>th</sup>.

**<u>DIII Girls, 1 Race:</u>** 8 Teams qualify and 16 additional qualifiers not on a team.

**DIV Girls**, 1 Race: 3 Teams qualify and 6 additional qualifiers not on a team.

**DII Boys, 2 Races:** 5 Teams qualify per race and 10 additional qualifiers not on a team.

**DIII Boys, 1 Race:** 7 Teams qualify and 14 additional qualifiers not on a team.

**DIV Boys, 1 Race:** 6 Teams qualify and 12 additional qualifiers not on a team.

Course Maps: Attached to this email/ SWDAB site. Available on Race Day.

**Entries:** A school may enter a maximum of seven runners in each assigned race. All runners, participants and alternates should be placed on the SWD XC Pass List.

Entry Deadline: Entries will open

<u>Late Entries:</u> Entries not submitted before the deadline are subject to an OHSAA imposed \$100 late entry penalty per team if approved by the OHSAA. Late entries are not guaranteed.

**Tournament Regulations:** Please review cross country tournament regulations

<u>Uniform Regulations:</u> Coaches are responsible for ensuring each athlete wears a legal uniform.

<u>Substitutions:</u> After the entry deadline, substitutions may be made using the online substitution form until Noon on Friday, October 17. After that time a paper substitution form, which will be provided in your packet, will need to be filled out on site and returned to at least 30 minutes before the scheduled start of the race. Note that you will only be able to substitute for an existing runner that you originally submitted. For example, if you submit five runners and then decide to add a sixth runner, you will not be able to do so as this is considered an addition instead of a substitution.

<u>Arrival Time:</u> Voice of America Park will be open to Teams starting at 8:30 am. Please do not send team representatives into the park early to set up tents. VOA will open to spectators at 8:00 am. <u>NOTE – All Division IV schools, there is another event in the park starting at 8:00 am. Please do not arrive prior to 8:30 am.</u>

<u>Team Check In:</u> All Teams and Individuals will check in at the entry to the course. There will be two tents with signs designating the Check In area.

<u>Bibs:</u> Bibs for all registered athletes will be provided in your team packets. Any bibs that must be replaced after packet pickup will be subject to a <u>\$20 bib replacement fee</u>.

#### **Prohibited Items:**

- Other than those approved by the meet manager for meet management purposes, no motorized or non-motorized vehicles (including scooters and bicycles) are permitted on the course at any time.
- Frisbees, footballs and other athletic items are also not allowed at the competition venue.
- Pets are prohibited. The OHSAA Service Dog policy can be found here: https://www.ohsaa.org/Portals/0/SchoolResources/ServiceDogs.pdf
- The use of drones by teams or spectators is prohibited.
- The use of air horns, bull horns (or other voice amplification devices), whistles, or other means to communicate pace or instructions to athletes by teams or spectators is prohibited as a violation of NFHS rule 4-6-5d.

**Tents**: Team Camps can be set up in the area behind and to the right of the start line.

<u>Weather:</u> If lightning or other dangerous weather is experienced, we will follow the OHSAA guidelines. The referee will coordinate the response effort with the meet manager.

<u>Athletic Trainer:</u> Certified athletic trainers will be available at the finish line. EMT's will also be present for the District Championship Meet at VOA.

<u>Awards:</u> The OHSAA provides awards for the 1st and 2nd place teams. The Southwest District does not provide individual awards.

<u>School Representative:</u> No team or individual will be allowed to compete in the District Tournament unless a coach or person authorized by the Board of Education is present throughout the Tournament. Team and individual entries unaccompanied by such a school representative may be disqualified, pending a ruling by the OHSAA' Executive Director.
