BOYS & GIRLS SWIMMING SECTIONAL AND DISTRICT MEETS - Rules and Regulations. Take what is needed from these rules and regulations for your Sectional and District Meets.

A school that actually competes in at least two interscholastic meets as a school team prior to the non-interscholastic cut-off date (January 20, 2025), is eligible for <u>relay event entry</u> at the Sectional/District Tournament.

- Each school may enter four (4) competitors in the Sectional and four (4) will compete in each event, with no cut-off times. January 20, 2025 is the THIRTY (30) DAY CUT-OFF FOR INDEPENDENT SWIMMING.
- BOYS AND GIRLS SECTIONAL & DISTRICT MEET ADMISSION:

Tickets for all sectional and district tournament games will be sold online through HomeTown Ticketing. Gate sales are permitted but will be done electronically via HomeTown Ticketing provided the event is not sold out. Cash sales are only permitted for meets held at school sites per OHSAA rules. Ticket prices will be:

- Admission for all sectional and district tournaments are:
 - Student (6 years old +) \$5.00
 - Adults \$8.00
 - Children under the age of five (5) are provided complimentary admission

School Administrators Passes: Each participating school will receive complimentary admission for eight school administrators, digitally, through HomeTown Ticketing. One digital code will be provided to each school. Each code will have eight tickets attached to the code. The same code will be utilized, as a school advances in the tournament. **There is no admittance without a QR code from HTT**

- 3. Tournament information will be sent by the manager to all schools (ADs & coaches) the week of January 20, 2025.
- 4. Schools shall complete the School Information Form and Eligibility Certificates on *MyOHSAA* no later than Monday, January 20, 2025.
- 5. Diving electronic entries must be received by the diving tournament manager, Lisa Werwinski (phone: 330-605-2810; email: werwinlm@miamioh.edu), by 5:00 pm, Sunday, February 2, 2025. Swimming electronic entries must be sent to the swimming tournament manager by 5:00 pm, Sunday, February 2, 2025.

Para-Swimming Competition

In 2025, para-swim competitors in the 50 Freestyle and 100 backstroke in the two identified categories described below *may* enter and compete at the District Tournament level; but, only the top 16 qualifiers (by time) in the state will advance to compete at the State level.

PARA CATEGORIES AND REGULATIONS: There are two categories for competition. These categories have been provided by US Paralympics Swimming.

- Para 1 Non-ambulatory (using a wheelchair) with limited use of all four extremities
- Para 2 Dwarfism, multiple limb deficiencies, ambulatory with assistance, can use a wheelchair with a high functioning upper body

To be considered as a para-athlete, the swimmer must have a documented permanent physical disability which limits one or more major life activities. The disability shall be confirmed by a licensed physician and maintained in the permanent file or on the student's PPE at the school. The verification form can be accessed at

Schools and athletes are responsible for adhering to all tournament entry procedures as described in General Sports Regulations #6.

Schools shall enter no more than four athletes in each para event. The para-swimming event files shall be available to enter swimmers in two categories and two events at the State Tournament level only.

The para-swimming entries will be sent to Pam Cook (pamswim@aol.com) by 5:00 pm, Sunday, February 2, 2025. There will be no electronic event files. Coaches must email the name & grade of each swimmer, the category they will swim in and the event(s). Athletes may enter one or both events in their Para category, the 50 Free and the 100 Backstroke. The Para events will be swum after each of the respective non-Para events in the State Division 2 meets.

RELAY TEAM MEMBERS MAY BE CHANGED FROM THE SECTIONAL TO DISTRICT TO STATE TOURNAMENT PROVIDING SWIMMERS ARE ON THE SCHOOL'S TOURNAMENT ELIGIBILITY LIST

AND WILL NOT HAVE PARTICIPATED IN MORE EVENTS THAN PERMITTED BY THE FEDERATION RULES.

Bovs Division I Advancers to District:

Swimming - This year there will be only 1 automatic qualifier from each sectional site. The thirty-two (32) fastest individuals across all sites will advance in the individual events qualifying to the District meet. For relay events, the fastest twenty-four (24) relays across all sites will advance to the district meet.

Diving - At Sectionals, a split board format will be followed. If necessary, a cut to 36 divers will be made after 8 dives. The top 32 divers across all sites, based on score, will be advanced from the Sectional to the District meet. This year there will be no automatic qualifiers from each sectional site.

Boys Division II Advancers to District:

Swimming - This year there will be only 1 automatic qualifier from each sectional site. The thirty-two (32) fastest individuals across all sites will advance in the individual events qualifying to the District meet. For relay events, the fastest twenty-four (24) relays across all sites will advance to the district meet.

Diving - At Sectionals, a split board format will be followed. If necessary, a cut to 36 divers will be made after 8 dives. The top 32 divers across all sites, based on score, will be advanced from the Sectional to the District meet. This year there will be no automatic qualifiers from each sectional site.

Girls Division I Advancers to District

Division I (Boys or Girls) Advancers to State

The District Tournament will automatically qualify three (3) in each swimming event to the State Meet, with twenty (20) at large qualifiers that will be selected on the basis of times recorded in the District Meet. At District diving, if necessary, a cut to 16 divers will be made after 8 dives. Representation for the State Diving Tournaments shall be calculated based on the entries for this current season.

Division II (Boys or Girls) Advancers to State

The District Tournament will automatically qualify three (3) in each swimming event to the State Meet, with twenty (20) at-large qualifiers that will be selected on the basis of times recorded in the District Meet. At District diving, if necessary, a cut to 16 divers will be made after 8 dives. Representation for the State Diving Tournaments shall be calculated based on the entries for this current season.

Coaches Admission

Deck passes for coaching staff will be distributed to coaches whose names are listed on and verified with the School Information Form. Deck passes for coaches attending Sectional tournaments will be distributed as follows:

1-5 qualifiers
 6-10 qualifiers
 Two Passes
 Three Passes
 Note that relay teams count as four (4) qualifiers.

Deck passes for coaches attending District tournaments will be distributed as follows:

1-3 qualifiers
 4-5 qualifiers
 6-10 qualifiers
 11 or more qualifiers
 Note that relay teams count as four (4) qualifiers.

All other coaches must purchase a ticket on-line in advance of the meet and present current credentials to gain access to the pool deck.

This policy applies to both Sectional and District meets. Coaches must be listed on the team entry information to qualify for entry.

WEATHER CANCELLATION POLICY

By District Board Action the following Weather Cancellation Policy has been adopted:

The Southwest District Board has established the following policy for cancellation or postponement of tournaments.

Schools participating in swimming/diving tournaments and reside in a county that experiences a Level Two (2) or Level Three (3) weather emergency, that SITE (tournament) will be postponed. Tournament managers must contact the District Board and make every effort to personally contact each school's coach, athletic director, or principal.

Schools are also encouraged to make use of the Board website (www.ohsaa.org/SWDAB-Home) for updated information regarding postponements and cancellations.

The tournament manager will contact the Board Secretary, who will work with the managers to contact the "News Media."

Prior to the start of tournaments, the managers will be instructed to make available to the Board, a contingency plan for weather emergencies. These site-specific plans will be posted on the District website.
