In the case of bad weather for the sectional tournament we will contact each school through the Athletic Directors or Head Coaches and enact one of the following plans:

Important Notes:

In order to keep the spectator areas open, we will be assigning each team an area in a crow's nest. Wrestlers need to keep all of their personal gear in the crow's nest, and we ask that the wrestlers remain in the crow's nest until called to the bullpen. Signage will indicate your team's area. Please have wrestlers ready when called to the bullpen.

Fans are allowed to photograph and videotape from the **Crows Nests**. Please leave an area clear for that purpose. Thank you.

There will be a hospitality room provided for coaches, officials and tournament personnel only. If your school athletic director, superintendent or principal attend, please invite them to the hospitality room as well.

Only two coaches or a coach and a wrestler are permitted in the two chairs at the corner of the mat. Statisticians/videographers in the stands unless you give up one of your two chairs to them. This WILL be required. Let your personnel know so there are not any conflicts. Our security personnel will be monitoring this closely.

Any food brought in for teams needs to be in their crow's nest area. No crock pots or other electrical devices can be accommodated. If you do bring food, please be prepared to clean up your area before awards. If you need trash bags, please let us know.

Professionalism of Coaches It is the moral obligation of all Ohio wrestling coaches to conduct themselves in a manner that reflects credit upon their high school, their profession and themselves. Personal grooming and appropriate dress is a standard of professionalism. The wearing of jeans, t-shirts, sweat suits and warmup suits (top or bottom), head wear and similar apparel are not considered suitable attire for coaches during the OHSAA sectional, district or state wrestling tournaments and, therefore, are prohibited. Coaches who are inappropriately dressed will not be allowed on the competition floor. Moral behavior and ethical conduct are part of winning and losing. Good sportsmanship, appearance, honor, and concern for the well-being of the competitors must be every coach's priority. The rules have been established in the spirit of this statement.
