- In accordance with Bylaw 3-6-1, at the beginning of each sport season, the principal/designee of each member school **MUST** prepare an eligibility certificate listing the students eligible under OHSAA bylaws to represent the school in each sport. Eligibility certificates shall be prepared for each sport in which the school participates and filed in the office of the principal/designee and available for inspection upon request. **Each school is permitted to use whatever certificate it feels is most effective, but this document represents the recommended OHSAA Eligibility Certificate.**
- Corrections, additions and deletions may be made as the sport season progresses and, must be filed in the office of the principal/designee.
- In order to participate in any interscholastic contest, students must be eligible in accordance with all sections of Bylaw 4-Student Eligibility (e.g. age, scholarship, semester, parent resides in Ohio, etc.)
- In column A, list students alphabetically by number of semesters in 7-8th grade since entering Grade 7 for the first time (1-2, 3-4)
 - Column B on this form is the student's birth date. This is important to help you identify students who turn 15 prior to August 1 of the upcoming school year.
 - Column C on this form is the date the student first enrolled at any 7-8 grade school. This information is important to enable you to track semesters.
 - Column D of this form addresses a student's scholastic eligibility. Every student, except incoming 7th graders (see Bylaw 4-4-5), are required to have received passing grades in a minimum of four classes during the immediately preceding grading period. You also want to make sure they are currently enrolled in at least four classes to ensure they have the opportunity to meet the scholastic requirement during the next grading period.
 - Columns E and F assists you in ensuring that each athlete has a parent in Ohio and that the student is a United States citizen, which are both requirements in order for the student to have any athletic participation at an OHSAA member school.
- Place non-enrolled students who are on home-education, those who attend non-public schools that do not sponsor the sport, and those who attend Community or STEM schools that do not sponsor the sport into the correct semester category. **Use the date of the student's first participation in an interscholastic contest as the "date first entered your school" and denote those students with an asterisk *.**
