

# 2024-25 OHSAA Tournament Audio Broadcast Fees



- Fees are “per contest” unless otherwise noted.
- Live audio broadcasts are permitted for all OHSAA tournament contests pending approval from the host site.
- In most cases, checks are to be made payable to the OHSAA.
- Stations that are pre-approved for delayed payment must submit the request application to the OHSAA and present the broadcast log sheet before each tournament game to be signed by the tournament manager or media coordinator.

## Audio Broadcast Information and Fees (Radio and Internet)

Rights fees for **low power, non-commercial** radio stations: \$25 per game or tournament (when fees are applicable). Rights fees are waived for high school student broadcasts on the school-owned website or school-controlled webpage.

Approval to broadcast a tournament contest must be granted by the tournament manager (or the OHSAA for state tournaments). Tournament managers may deny broadcast requests for reasons such as lack of previous broadcast coverage of high school sports, lack of coverage of the teams competing in the contest, or lack of available broadcast space, in which case the participating schools shall be asked to decide which broadcast outlet should be designated their priority broadcast outlet(s).

During regular-season contests, the OHSAA expects the host school to accommodate the primary broadcast outlet of the visiting school. During OHSAA tournament contests, the priority media of both participating schools should be accommodated equally, even if the higher seed is hosting the contest.

### Additional Radio and Audio Webcast Information

The OHSAA reserves the right to grant exclusive rights to a company for coverage (live or delayed) of a state tournament and/or finals, as well as the first right of refusal for live or tape-delayed coverage of all other OHSAA tournament events. Should exclusivity be granted, approval to broadcast a tournament contest must be granted by procedures approved by the OHSAA Board of Directors.

## Video Broadcast Rights Fees (TV and Streaming)

### General Notes

- Spectrum News 1 is the official TV partner of the OHSAA. If Spectrum News 1 selects a contest for TV coverage, there may not be any other video play-by-play video productions of that contest (live or tape-delayed). If Spectrum selects a contest for streaming coverage, then tape-delayed video play-by-play productions are permitted if the facility can accommodate additional requests, but Spectrum gets the primary positioning.
- The NFHS Network is the official streaming partner of the OHSAA. If the NFHS Network selects a contest for streaming coverage, there may not be any other live video play-by-play productions of that contest. Tape-delayed video play-by-play productions are permitted if the facility can accommodate the additional requests, but the NFHS Network gets the primary positioning.
- For OHSAA tournament contests not selected by Spectrum nor the NFHS Network, live video (TV and/or streaming) is permitted in some situations per this document (see the sport-specific section for permissions and fees) and only if the host site can accommodate the request and a rights fee is paid to the OHSAA.

### Delayed Video

- Rights fees for tape-delayed coverage by **educational access (non-commercial) stations** are \$50 per contest (where fees are applicable) unless otherwise noted (see wrestling).
- Tape-delayed video broadcasts may not begin until the contest has concluded.

### Video Rights Fees

- Spectrum and the NFHS Network are official partners of the OHSAA and they have already paid rights fees, therefore they do not pay single-game fees at the site of the contest.
- Broadcast fees are "per game" unless otherwise noted. Checks should be made payable to the OHSAA unless the host site directs otherwise.
- Please see page 2 of the OHSAA media regulations for details when a media outlet may be charged a second rights fee for providing more than one form of coverage of a game
- Rights fees are waived only for school-owned websites and school-controlled webpages (including social media platforms) in which students are providing the announcing and assisting with production.

## Football

- Live television play-by-play coverage is not permitted for OHSAA football playoff games.
- If a game is not televised by Spectrum News 1, it is available first for streaming coverage by Spectrum, then by the NFHS Network. If a game is streamed by Spectrum or the NFHS Network, delayed video coverage is permitted if the stadium can accommodate the request.
- If a playoff game is not covered by Spectrum or the NFHS Network, then it is available for live streaming coverage per the chart below.
