

Welcome to the OHSAA Track and Field State Tournament. We appreciate your coverage and are pleased to once again return to Jesse Owens Memorial Stadium.

MEDIA WORK SPACE: All media must utilize the locker rooms underneath the stands on the west side of the stadium, with additional space in the softball press box. Media are not permitted in the Jesse Owens Memorial Stadium press box.

NOTE ON MEDIA CREDENTIALS: Please note that credentials are non-transferable and that parents, school or "team" photographers and coaches may not receive media credentials to OHSAA state tournaments. Media outlets found to be in violation of this regulation could have reduced access at future events.

CROSS THE TRACK: Media may cross the track at the southwest corner (finish line area) and in the middle of track on the west side (press box side). Please check with security staff before crossing.

PODIUM PHOTOS: Media can obtain podium photos on the infield side of the track. After a brief time for media photos, the area will be cleared for spectator photos.

INTERVIEWS: Interviews are permitted on the infield of the track and media may wait in the media tents located beside the awards podium.

WIRELESS INTERNET ACCESS: Free wireless internet access is available throughout the facility. Details will be provided at the media check-in tent in the southwest corner of the stadium.

YOUR HOSTS: State Tournament Manager Dave DeAngelo, OHSAA Track & Field Administrator Dustin Ware, OHSAA Administrators Bob Goldring and Tim Stried (Friday only). OHSAA communications assistants Scott Rex, Zachary Taylor, Cam Kozlay and Gavyn Freeland will be on-site both days to assist the media.
