**STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS DATE AND SCHEDULE:** The state championship games will be played over two days.

Friday, June 7

4 p.m. - Division II Girls

7 p.m. - Division I Girls

Saturday, June 8

1 p.m. - Division II Boys

4 p.m. - Division I Boys

**LOCATION:** Historic Crew Stadium, Columbus. The physical address is One Black & Gold Blvd., Columbus, OH 43211.

**CREDENTIAL REQUESTS:** Scan and email your completed credential application form to Tim Stried at the OHSAA office [tstried@ohsaa.org](mailto:tstried@ohsaa.org) (or fax to 614-267-1677). The deadline to submit credential application requests is Thursday, June 2 at Noon.

**CREDENTIAL CONFIRMATION:** Upon processing a credential application, the OHSAA will send a confirmation email to the media person who submitted the application form and will post a list on the News & Media page at [OHSAA.org](http://OHSAA.org) of those media members who have been approved for credentials. Denied requests will be notified by email.

**PARKING:** Media will receive parking instructions in the confirmation email.

**CREDENTIAL PICK UP:** Credentials will be held at the media entrance at Historic Crew Stadium. The specific gate will be explained in the confirmation email explained above. Media must show photo ID to receive their credential.

**MEDIA WORK AREAS:** Media members are permitted to remain in the press box after each contest, or work in the Champions Lounge, which is located field level in the southwest corner of the stadium, near the postgame interview area (see later note). Photographers can work in those two designated spaces, as well. There are approximately 20 seats available for media in the press box.

**BROADCASTS:** The broadcast booth on the west side of Historic Crew Stadium is available. A reminder that live video broadcasting of the lacrosse state championships is only permitted by the NFHS Network. All other broadcasts can be live audio or tape-delayed video. WiFi is available. Broadcast media outlets that need an internet line connection shall notify the OHSAA when applying for credentials. The media outlet will be responsible for any fees assessed by the venue.

**POSTGAME INTERVIEWS:** There is a postgame press conference after each game in the Champions Lounge, which is located field level in the southwest corner of the stadium.
