STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS DATE: All four state championship games will be played on Saturday, June 5, 2021.

LOCATION: Selby Stadium, Ohio Wesleyan University. The physical address is 45 South Henry Street, Delaware, OH 43015.

YOUR HOSTS: The state tournament manager at Selby Stadium is Michael Taylor. The OHSAA lacrosse administrator is Beau Rugg. OWU sports information will provide game statistics and assist with other press box questions.

CREDENTIAL REQUESTS: Fax (or scan and email) your request form to Tim Stried at the OHSAA office (614-267-1677, tstried@ohsaa.org). The deadline to submit credential application requests is Friday, June 5 at Noon.

CREDENTIAL CONFIRMATION: Upon processing a credential application, the OHSAA will send a confirmation email to those media requesting state tournament credentials and will post a list on the News & Media page at OHSAA.org of those media members who have been approved for credentials. Denied requests will be notified via email.

PARKING: There are no media parking passes issued for the lacrosse state championship games and there is not a designated media parking lot. Parking is available on a first-come, first-served basis in the parking lots south of Selby Stadium, including one lot adjacent to the stadium and three more lots south of the stadium on Henry Street, serving the OWU Science Center, Branch Rickey Arena, the tennis courts and the aquatic center.

CREDENTIAL PICK UP: Credentials will be held at the media entrance at Selby Stadium, which is the gate facing Henry Street in the southwest corner of the stadium. Media must show photo ID to receive their credential.

MEDIA WORK AREA: Media members are permitted to remain in the press box after each contest. Space permitting, photographers can work in the press box, as well. There are approximately 20 seats available for media in the first floor of the press box, as well as one broadcast booth.

Most broadcasts will be encouraged to use wifi or a cell connection. A landline telephone line is also available (station must use an 800 number). OWU SID Mark Beckenbach will place the broadcasts. One broadcast booth is available on the first level of the press box, while a secondary booth is available on the second level.

WIRELESS: Wireless access is available in the press box for credentialed media. Please ask OWU staff for the passcode.

VIDEO BROADCAST INFORMATION: Media outlets that request to do video play-by-play of an OHSAA state tournament contest shall contact Tim Stried at the OHSAA for details.
