Welcome to the OHSAA Track and Field State Tournament. We appreciate your coverage and are pleased to return to Jesse Owens Memorial Stadium for this year's event.

MEDIA WORKSPACE: Media are **NOT** permitted in the press box. Media workspace is available in the locker rooms under the main grandstands. WiFi, power, beverages and box lunches will be provided. Overflow workspace is also available in the OSU softball stadium press box.

NOTE ON MEDIA CREDENTIALS: Please note that school or team photographers, parents of state qualifiers and coaches may not receive media credentials to the OHSAA track and field state championships. Media outlets found to be in violation of this regulation could have reduced access at future state tournaments.

CROSS THE TRACK: Media may cross the track at the southwest corner (finish line area) and in the middle of track on the west side (press box side). Please check with security staff before crossing.

PODIUM PHOTOS: Media can obtain podium photos on the infield side of the track. After a brief time for media photos, the area will be cleared for spectator photos.

INTERVIEWS: Interviews are permitted on the infield of the track and media may wait in the media tents located beside the awards podium.

WIRELESS INTERNET ACCESS: Wireless internet access is available. Details will be provided at the media check-in tent in the southwest corner of the stadium.

YOUR HOSTS: State Tournament Manager Dave DeAngelo, OHSAA Track & Field Administrator B.J. Duckworth, OHSAA Administrators Bob Goldring and Tim Stried. OHSAA communications assistants Scott Rex, Saige Arnhold and Megan Henning will be on-site both days to assist the media.
