Boys State Tournament: March 19, 20 & 21 at Schottenstein Center

Semifinal games Thursday and Friday at noon, approx. 2:00, 6:00 and approx. 8:00
Championship games Saturday at 10:45, 2:00, 5:15 and 8:30

Skyview Networks – Satellite Distribution

Skyview will add OHSAA Radio Network affiliates into their system for the basketball state tournament broadcasts. Affiliates have access to schedule the broadcasts on their Skyview XDS receivers. The program name is “OHSAA Championships.”

Skyview will provide four automation triggers: Beginning of Broadcast, Local Break, Legal ID and End of Broadcast. Skyview will provide the following netcues/relays for affiliates to add to their receiver relay mapping:

Cue	Name
OHSAAASOG	Beginning of Broadcast
OHSAAEOG	End of Game
OHSAAID	Legal ID
OHSAALOCAL	Local Break (see program log for specific local breaks)

Broadcast Elements

Semifinal Sessions Programming Note: The semifinals of the girls and boys basketball state tournaments are doubleheaders. The first game has a hard start time for the pregame show (please see the program logs), but the second games do not, as that depends on the length of the first game. The announcers will give timing updates and there will be a five-minute countdown prior to the second game, followed by a one-minute rejoin clip. Skyview will use the “Beginning of Broadcast” relay for the every broadcast.

Local and Network Breaks:

Please see the program logs regarding breaks and verbal outcues by the announcers. Automation notes are described above. During local breaks, local stations may not air spots promoting alcohol, tobacco, gambling, political parties, guns or ads considered in poor taste.

Pregame and Postgame Shows:

- Network join time is 20 minutes prior to the announced start time.
- Listen for a five-minute countdown on the network prior to the first game of each session, followed by a one-minute network reset clip.
- Postgame shows run approximately 10 minutes for the semifinals and 20 minutes for the championship games.
