Skyview Networks – Satellite Distribution

Skyview will add OHSAA Radio Network affiliates into their system for the basketball state championship broadcasts. Affiliates have access to schedule the broadcasts on their Skyview XDS receivers. The program name is "OHSAA Championships."

Skyview will provide four automation triggers: Beginning of Broadcast, Local Break, Legal ID and End of Broadcast. Skyview provides the following netcues/relays for receiver relay mapping:

<u>Cue</u>	Name
OHSAASOG	Beginning of Broadcast
OHSAAID	Legal ID
OHSAALOCAL	Local Break (see program log for specific local breaks)
OHSAAEOG	End of Game

Pregame and Postgame Shows:

- Network join time is 20 minutes prior to the announced tip time.
- The producer will give a three-minute countdown on the network prior to each game.
- Postgame shows run approximately 10 minutes for the semifinals and 20 minutes for the championship games.
