1 - Update on Renewal Timeline

The traditional June 1 - June 30 renewal window has been shifted to begin on June 15 through July 15.

Fall Sports: June 15 - July 15

There is no "late renewal period". There will be no late fee.

Winter Sports: June 15 - September 30

Late Renewal: October 1- October 31, late fee of \$50

Spring Sports: June 15 - December 31

Late Renewal: January 1 - January 31, late fee of \$50

<u>SPRING SPORT OFFICIALS:</u> Please keep the books from the preseason mailing you received during the 2019-20 school year. New officials should keep the materials from their officiating course. Each **spring** sport renewal fee will be reduced by \$10 (baseball, boys lacrosse, girls lacrosse, softball, track & field). The renewal fee structure will be \$50 for the first spring sport and \$20 for each additional spring sport. The NFHS has announced that there will be no rule changes for spring sports in the 2020-21 school year, and they will not print 2020-21 rule or case books.

Note: Spring sport officials will not receive a preseason mailing in 2021.

You will receive more information in an email in June prior to June 15.
