DOUBLE FOULS

Q1: 4.19.8 (C): A1 drives for a try and jumps and releases the ball. Contact occurs between A1 and B1 after the release and before airborne shooter A1 returns one foot to the floor. One official rules a blocking foul on B1 and the other official rules a charging foul on A1. The try is **successful**.

A. No basket. The contact by A1 should be recognized as the first contact and therefore resulting in a player control foul.

- B. Count the basket as the try was successful. A1 will shoot one free throw because of the blocking foul by B1.
- C. Count the basket. Both fouls are recorded resulting in a double foul. Play will resume at the point of interruption, which is a throw-in for Team B from anywhere along the end line.

Answer:

Q2: 4.19.8 (C): A1 drives for a try and jumps and releases the ball. Contact occurs between A1 and B1 after the release and before airborne shooter A1 returns one foot to the floor. One official rules a blocking foul on B1 and the other official rules a charging foul on A1. The try is **unsuccessful**.

- A. Both fouls are recorded and play will resume at the point of interruption which is a try in flight. Ball will be put in play using the alternating-possession procedure.
- B. Both fouls are recorded. Play will resume with an A1 throw-in at the nearest designated spot on the baseline.
- C. Both fouls are recorded. Play will resume with a B1 throw-in on the end-line.

TEAM CONTROL

Q3: 4.19.7 (B): A1 is passing the ball to A2 in the team's frontcourt when B2 deflects the pass. As A2 and B2 are attempting to retrieve the loose ball, A2 illegally pushes B2 from behind and a foul is ruled. Team B is in the bonus.

- A. Player B2 will be awarded two free throws as Team B is in the bonus situation.
- B. No free throws are awarded as this is a team control foul. Award the ball to Team B at a designated spot out of bounds closest to where the foul occurred.
- C. Player B2 will be awarded a one and bonus free throw.

Answer:

Q4: 4.19.7 (D): A1 has the ball for a throw-in in Team A's backcourt. The throw-in pass deflects off of A2. As A2 and B2 are attempting to retrieve the loose throw-in pass, A2 illegally pushes B2 from behind and the action is ruled a foul. Team B is in the bonus.

- A. Player B2 will be awarded two free throws as Team B is in the bonus situation.
- B. No free throws are awarded as this is a team control foul. Award the ball to Team B at one of the four designated throw-in spots to where the foul occurred.
- C. Player B2 will be awarded a one and bonus free throw.
