Re: Officials Amnesty Program

You are receiving this email because your OHSAA license is currently not active in the sport(s) of «FH» «FB» «SO» «VB» «BK» «GYM» «IH» «SD» «WR» «BB» «BLAX» «GLAX» «SB» «TF», and we would love to have you back. Sports may be on pause at the moment but they will return, and now is the time to plan for the future. To encourage former officials to get their license back active, we are excited to unveil a new one-time amnesty program.

- Officials who did not renew in the 2019-20 school year will be able to renew for the 2020-21 school year without having to go through the reinstatement process. Just log on to your myOHSAA profile and you will be able to renew like you used to starting June 1.
- Officials suspended for not attending local meetings in their last sport season (2019-20 for fall and winter, 2018-19 for spring) will be able to renew for the 2020-21 school year without having to go through the reinstatement process. To complete this, you will again just need to log on to your profile at myOHSAA.org and follow the steps starting June 1.
- Inactive officials who are inactive before spring 2019 will still need to get their license back active through the reinstatement and testing process.
