Good day, everyone.

A clarification is needed for the application of new NF 12.3.2 and NF 12.3.3. Let's start with those rules.

NF 12.3.2 A player shall be penalized for handling if they score in the opponent's goal directly from their hand/arm, even if accidental, including by the goalkeeper. NF 12.3.3 A player shall be penalized for handling if they score in the opponent's goal immediately after the ball has touched their hand/arm, even if accidental.

Principles

- 1.) If a player accidentally or deliberately handles and the ball goes directly into goal, the goal does not count and a direct free kick is awarded to the opponent from the spot of the foul. NF 12.3.2.
- 2.) If a player accidentally or deliberately handles and then scores immediately, the goal does not count and a direct free kick is awarded to the opponent from the spot of the foul. NF 12.3.3.
- 3.) If a player accidentally handles the ball, which goes to a teammate who scores, THE GOAL COUNTS. NF 12.3.2 and NF 12.3.3 do not apply to this situation.
- 4.) Under NF 12.3.2 and NF 12.3.3, whether the handling be accidental or deliberate DOES NOT MATTER. The goal does not count and a direct free kick is awarded to the opponent.
