

SPORTSMANSHIP RESPONSIBILTIES FOR Public Address Announcers

- Understand that this position is very important for the administration of the contest.
- Review the sites' emergency action plan with the host site director/manager/ administrator-in charge, and have emergency announcements available as needed.
- Always remain impartial and exemplify good taste at all times.
- Only provide information, not commentary. Criticizing the officials is NEVER acceptable.
- The visiting team and their fans are your guests and should be treated as such. Creating an intimidating environment is NOT appropriate.
- Make an effort to get correct pronunciations of all players, coaches and officials.
