Important Regional Information to be Submitted

With the short time between the Regional and State Tournament, all preparations begin during Regionals for the State Tournament. As a result, there are several important items you must complete now. ROSTER/TRAVEL PARTY LIST

Complete this form electronically and send to your Regional manager no later than the Monday following your District Final game. In addition, email this to Scott Rex (srex@ohsaa.org) no later than Wednesday, June 4. Please note there is space for 22 players—make certain spelling is correct, as this is the way names will appear in the State Tournament program.

SEASON RESULTS FORM

Complete and submit this form as requested by Wednesday, June 4, but you are permitted to update it as you progress through the Regional Tournament. Your final form will be due by the State Tournament Finalists' Meeting on Monday, June 9, should you advance.

TEAM PHOTO & IDENTIFICATION

Submitting this now is extremely important for the State Tournament, to allow for printing of programs. Please submit the *Team Photograph Identification Form* along with a digital copy of your photo to Scott Rex (srex@ohsaa.org). If you choose to submit a printed photo, please mail the photo no later than Monday following your District Final game. If you submit a hard copy photograph, it will be returned to you.

REGIONAL SITES

Please be aware that while the goal is to keep the Regional games dates and times as scheduled, the Executive Director's office is authorized by the Board of Directors to make any changes to game sites and/or times. This can and may occur when possible, to accommodate graduations or other significant conflicts. Should you anticipate having a scheduling conflict, please contact Emily Mason as soon as possible. All submitted conflicts will be reviewed but *are not guaranteed to be changed*.

Should there be any weather delays and/or postponements, those will be communicated to the schools by the site manager and Emily Mason.

BATTING PRACTICE AT REGIONAL SITES

Batting practice is permitted at Regional sites prior to tournament games if the site has the availability; however, it is not mandatory or guaranteed at a site. Please make sure you check with the Regional manager for their policy. If batting practice is permitted at the site, the opportunity to conduct batting practice must be afforded to both teams.

COACHING ELIGIBILITY

All coaches in the dugout must comply with dress code regulations as described in the NFHS Rules Book. Only coaches with valid Pupil Activity Coaching Permits issued by the Ohio Department of Education are permitted to coach and be in uniform in the dugout.

ROSTER/TRAVEL PARTY LIST

This is an additional reminder that a maximum of 28 individuals are admitted via the pass gate and in the dugout. This is to be made up of the 22 (maximum) players in uniform, coaches and other team personnel, for a total of 28 individuals. The 22 players will be the only players permitted in the dugout or on the field for warm-up or any part of the contest. The 22 players may be changed from game to game throughout the tournament; however, any player in uniform must meet all eligibility requirements established by OHSAA Bylaws.

The Team Roster/Travel Party List shall be used at every tournament level across the state and every dugout shall be limited to 28 individuals, including the 22 players in uniform. All tournament managers should be enforcing this, so we ask for the cooperation of the schools participating as well. UMPIRES

Umpires for the Regional Tournament have been assigned by the Executive Director's office. The umpires assigned for the tournaments are determined by a combination rating and voting system approved by the Board of Directors. Names of the officials will not be announced in advance of the games. In accordance with NFHS Rules, the decisions and rulings of the officials will be final.

GAME BALLS

The Rawlings R100 baseball is the official game ball of all levels of OHSAA Baseball tournament play.
