<u>Re:</u> Changes to Upcoming Basketball Season

Date: October 26, 2021

Please review the important information below regarding changes for the upcoming 2021-22 season. This information is being shared with all basketball officials as well.

Running Clock:

The running clock was adopted by the State Board at the October meeting and will be utilized this 2021-22 season for both the regular season <u>at all levels</u> and state tournament. Any time a score differential reaches 35 points during the second half, a running clock shall be utilized. After the 35 point score differential has been met but the score drops below 30 points, the clock reverts to regular NFHS timing. (This eliminates timing issues in a faster paced contest). The clock shall be stopped only for an injured player on the court, team time-outs, or when there is any unusual delay deemed necessary by the officials.

7th and 8th Grade Coaches Box:

The coaches box in 7th and 8th grade has <u>NOT</u> been eliminated and still exists.

Basketball Regulation Adjustment for the 2021-22 season:

The OHSAA Executive Director's Office has decided that teams may play two contests in a day of the same level, with a maximum of eight quarters per day for each student-athlete. The eight-quarter limit for the day is only permitted IF two games of the same level are being played in the same day. Season quarter limits and maximum number of contests per season listed in the basketball regulations remain. This adjustment was presented to the Board at the October meeting.
