

OHSAA Cross Country State Championships National Trail Raceway Course Map



Map Key:

- 1) Spectator Parking (arriving from the East) Lot #1
- 2) Gate A Spectator Entrance and School Transportation (buses & vans) Entrance
- 3) Gate A Spectator Parking (arriving from the East) Lot #2 including RVs no tailgating in spectator parking area \$25 charge, plus ticket charges to tailgate at preferred sites inside venue
- 4) Contestant & Coach Pass Gate Enter Gate A
- 5) Bus Parking (after contestants disembark at #4)
- 6) School Van Parking (after contestants disembark at #4)
- 7) General Admission Gates (4 Gates—2 on east side; 2 on west side)
- 8) Gate B Officials, Media and Meet Personnel Entrance
- 9) Parking Lot for Officials, Media and Meet Personnel
- 10) Media Check-In after parking at #9
- 11) Team Camps
- 12) Starting Line
- 13) Finish Line & Spectator Grandstand
- 14) 1600M Split
- 15) 3200M Split
- 16) Concessions & Restrooms
- 17) Vendor Meet Program & Apparel Sales
- 18) Handicap Vehicle Gate & Parking (Turn on Flasher Lights on Rt. 40 went approaching venue)
- 19) Gate D Spectator Parking arriving from the West Lot #3

Spectator Travel Directions:

National Trail Raceway: 2650 National Road SW, State Route 40 | Hebron, OH 43025

Traveling from the North: Travel south on Rt. 37. Turn right onto Rt. 40. Follow parking instructions into Lot #1 or Lot #2 (Gate A) on Map Key.

Traveling from the East: Exit I-70 at Rt. 37. Travel Rt 37N to Rt. 40. Turn left onto Rt. 40. Follow parking instructions into Lot #1 or Lot #2 (Gate A) on Map Key.

Traveling from the South on Rt. 37: Travel north on Rt. 37 to Rt. 40. Turn left onto Rt. 40. Follow parking instructions into Lot #1 or Lot #2 (Gate A) on Map Key.

Traveling from the South on Rt. 158: Travel north on Rt. 158 to Rt.40. Turn right onto Rt. 40. Follow parking instructions into Gate D #19 on Map.

Traveling from the West: Exit I-70 at Rt. 158. Travel north on Rt. 158 to Rt.40. Turn right onto Rt. 40. Follow parking instructions into Gate D #19 on Map.

All Handicap Vehicles: Traveling from either direction on Rt. 40. Use hazard flashers when approaching National Trail venue. Follow parking instructions to park in handicap area. Free shuttle transport from parking to spectator areas.
