Hudson (17-3-0) defeated Cincinnati Indian Hill (13-5-0) 4-0 and broke a state tournament record Thursday night in the first semifinal game of the OHSAA field hockey state tournament at Thomas Worthington High School.

Senior Marita Johnson set the tone for the Explorers early on, scoring two goals within the first period of play at 11:47 and 8:18. Junior Kaci Ramlow scored the third goal in the second half at 4:47 while junior Sarah Lozina extended the lead for Hudson with the final goal at 0:00. Hudson defense allowed only three shots on goal by Indian Hill with junior goalie Hailey Nagaj securing all three saves.

Hudson set a new OHSAA field hockey state tournament record with 26 penalty corners, topping previous recordholder Shaker Heights' 15 penalty corners from the 2014 state semifinal game.

This marks the 17th time the Explorers have made it to the OHSAA field hockey state tournament and the 13th time heading to the state championship game. They have won three state titles. Indian Hill was making its sixth appearance in the OHSAA field hockey state tournament.
