IMPORTANT PAPERWORK & LOGO SUBMISSIONS

TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS

Please review the 2024 Field Hockey Tournament Regulations on the Field Hockey webpage <u>HERE</u>. Regulations that address number in uniform, number of individuals in the bench area, etc., that should have been enforced in previous rounds and will be strictly enforced at the State Tournament level.

SIZE OF SQUAD (25)

Each squad is restricted to **25 players in uniform** and this is strictly enforced. The 25 in uniform may change from game to game, as long as they are eligible. There is a maximum of 35 individuals (includes players, coaches, Athletic Trainers, managers, etc.) permitted in the bench area. Their admission is described below.

ADMISSION FOR TEAM PERSONNEL

Though pass lists were submitted prior to your Regional game, admission for the 35 total individuals at the State Tournament is done entirely through the use of **bag tags**. These bag tags will be included in your packet pick-up as soon as you arrive at Thomas Worthington High School. Each of the 35 individuals provided bag tags will be required to show their bag tag prior to admittance through the pass gate. **There will be no pass list used at State Semifinal or State Final contests.**

SCHOOL ADMINISTRATOR COMPLIMENTARY ADMISSION (8)

Please continue to use the 8 complimentary codes provided from HomeTown Ticketing for school administrators. They are typically intended for the Superintendent (2), Principal (2), Athletic Director (2), Bus Driver (1), Other (1). These 8 individuals will need to

utilize the main entrance for admission, so their ticket may be scanned. There will be no pass list utilized at the State Semifinals or Finals and their admission is only granted via the actual complimentary ticket through HomeTown Ticketing.

GAME ADMISSION

Tickets for admission to State Semi-Final and Final games are \$10.00 and \$15.00 for adults and may be purchased on our Ticketing webpage (https://www.ohsaa.org/tickets). Children under the age of five are provided complimentary admission.

TEAM & SPECTATOR PARKING

Parking is free and there is plenty of parking available in between the school and the stadium. Parking maps and further information will be addressed in the Finalist Manual.

AWARDS CEREMONY

A very important part of the State Finals is the presentation of awards, both individual and team, to the State Champion and the Runner-Up. Though this will be mentioned in the Finalists Meeting, it is important and required for both teams to participate in this ceremony with the utmost respect it deserves.

After shaking hands, teams will be asked to line up in front of the main bleachers. Names will be called and school administrators from each school will assist our Board of Directors and OHSAA Staff with the presentation of individual awards. Individuals will be expected to wear their medal around their neck and observe the other team receiving their awards. Fans will not be permitted on to the field at any time.

GAME OFFICIALS

Game officials for the State Tournament are selected from procedures adopted by the OHSAA's Board of Directors and are assigned by the Executive Director's office. There are no protests of decisions and interpretations of the rules by officials during contests per OHSAA Bylaw 8, Section 3. Decisions and interpretations are final.

LIVE STREAM

All State Semifinal and Final matches will be live streamed through the NFHS Network. Links will be posted to our Field Hockey Tournament Coverage page on our website—these might not be available until the day of the game.

FIELD ACCESS FOR STATE CHAMPIONSHIP GAME

2 field-access passes will be provided to school administrators. These credentials may be used to be on the field during the award ceremony on Saturday. Emily will be in touch with the school Athletic Director to provide them with these passes. She will utilize the cell phone number of the administrator(s) in attendance that is listed on the *State Final Information Sheet* on page 3.

AWARDS CEREMONY INSTRUCTIONS

The name(s) provided on the *State Final Information Sheet* (pg. 3) will be announced as assisting with the Awards Presentation at the conclusion of the State Championship game on Saturday. With approximately 5 minutes remaining in the game, please come down to the field level and someone from our staff will assist you onto the field to be present for your school's awards ceremony. We will ask your assistance in lining up your team for the awards. We do require both teams to participate in the ceremony and respect the presentation of awards to the opponent.

Our normal protocol for awards is:

- 1. Teams will line up in front of the home bleachers
- School administrators will place the medal around the neck of the individual(s)
- 3. Announcer will read script congratulating teams and coach will accept the team trophy to the school
