# **Questions of the Week**

Here are a couple of questions I received this week:

- 1. **Scrimmage Kicks:** FG attempts are scrimmage kicks just like punts. If it reaches the end zone and misses, it is a touchback. If it rolls dead at the one or out of bounds at the one, the spot is the 1-yard line. Check this play: <u>Video Link</u>
- 2. Can a school play 2 games per week? Yes. Regulations limit players to 4 quarters in a day and 50 quarters (9-12) per season.
- 3. Please send the Weekly Word to your Middle School Coaches!

## Rules

- 1. Jerseys: NFHS Rules state that visiting teams shall wear white jerseys.
- 2. NFHS Rule 3, Section 1, Article 6 states that halftime must be a minimum of 10 minutes and no more than 20 minutes. I cannot grant permission to go beyond 20 minutes.
- 3. The "bunch kick" was never made illegal. Free kicks (kickoffs) must comply with Rule 6, Section 1, Articles 2, 3 and 4.
- **4. Point Differential:** Running clock when a 30-point margin is reached in the second half. Both coaches may agree on a running clock if the 30- point margin is reached in the first half.
