- 1. NFHS Rule 3, Section 1, Article 6 states that halftime must be a minimum of 10 minutes and no more than 20 minutes. I cannot grant permission to go beyond 20 minutes. Please plan accordingly with your events.
- 2. **Athletic Directors!** Check your DragonFly accounts for ejection reports and remember to add your response.

Rules

- 1. **Scrimmage Kicks:** FG attempts are scrimmage kicks just like punts. If it reaches the end zone and misses, it is a touchback. If it rolls dead at the one or out of bounds at the one, the spot is the 1-yard line. Check this play: <u>Video Link</u>
- 2. The "bunch kick" was never made illegal. Free kicks (kickoffs) must comply with Rule 6, Section 1, Articles 2, 3 and 4.
- 3. **Point Differential:** Running clock when a 30-point margin is reached in the second half. Both coaches may agree on a running clock if the 30- point margin is anytime in the game. 2024PointDifferentialRule.pdf
