Questions of the Week

Here are a couple of questions I received this week:

1. Can a school host a Combine during the season? No. See 7.2.1 in the following link on page 69: [Handbook.pdf](#)
2. We are working on the drone situation for playoffs. In the meantime, check this link for important information we were given from the FAA: [Drone Slides.pptx](#)
3. We have recognized Girls Flag Football as an OHSAA sanctioned sport for Spring 2027. Playing rules and tournament structure will be finalized by the end of the Fall. **The rules will specify 5 on 5 as the game format.**

Rules

1. Helping the runner (tush push) is a point of emphasis for the NFHS. I have informed officials that if a player puts hands on the runner and pushes, it should be called. See this: [Tush Push.MP4](#)
2. **Equipment:** Players may not play unless they are legally equipped. We need to follow this rule! The national rules committee wants to penalize coaches for unsportsmanlike conduct for these violations. I don't want that (and neither do you). Let's follow the rule we have.
3. Visors: NFHS Rule 1-5-3c4 states that visors must be clear and that tinted eyewear (glasses) may be worn under the clear visor. **A prescription from a Dr. does not supersede this rule.** Any accommodation outside of NFHS Rules (NFHS Rule 1, Section 8) for an athlete in football must be approved by the OHSAA office (Beau Rugg). The accommodation is only granted if the rule does not resolve the player's condition. Have your Athletic Director contact me.

Reminders

1. The online Coach's state rules interpretation meeting is available on your MyOHSAA account. 90% of you have already completed!
2. The deadline with a \$50 late fee is October 7.
3. **Schools that do not complete the online meeting will not be eligible for the tournament.**
