DIVISION I BOYS AND DIVISION I GIRLS Information for State Golf Tournament Qualifiers

- I. **DATE** October 20 & 21, 2023.
- 2 LOCATION Ohio State University Golf Course, 3605 Tremont Road, Columbus 43211.
- 3. SITE MANAGER Brian Kelly, Ohio State University Golf Club. Telephone 614-514-4653.
- 4. **COACHES MEETING** There will be a meeting in the Club House on Thursday, October 19 at 4:00 P.M. with coaches or school representatives of Boys Division I and Girls Division I schools.
- 5. GREEN FEES Paid by the OHSAA.
- 6. PRACTICE ROUNDS Team (5 individuals only) and individual qualifiers may play a practice round on Thursday prior to the start of the tournaments. Each individual shall play one ball only during their practice round. Practice rounds are optional and limited to the day before the tournament. Tee times are pre-arranged. District tournament managers will inform qualifying teams and individuals of their respective times.

Boys Division I practice round on the Scarlet Course with tee times beginning at 10:40 A.M.

Girls Division I practice round on the Gray Course with tee times beginning at 10:40 A.M.

Note: Once teams or individuals have qualified for the state tournament, play on the course where they will play (Scarlet or Gray) in the state tournament is not permitted. Ethics and integrity are of the utmost importance in regard to this regulation. Failure to comply may result in disqualification

7. MANDATORY PRE-PAY RANGE FEE - \$300 for team, \$75 for individual

Must be paid when picking up packet prior to practice round on Thursday. Check should be made payable to: Ohio State Golf Club

Note: OSUGC will provide (1) bag of balls after the round per player on both Thursday and Friday. OSUGC will need to close the range by 5:30 PM to clean pick the range and prepare for the next day.

- 8. ADMISSIONS Admissions to the State Golf Tournament will be \$16.00 per day.
- 9. PASSES Passes shall be provided to competitors and coaches according to the following schedule:
 - 9.1 Individuals number of qualifiers plus one coach pass
 - 9.2 Team six total passes
- 10. USGA Rules USGA Rules will be played in the State Tournament if conditions permit.
- 11. **RESPONSIBILITY** Transportation, meals, and lodging shall be the responsibility of the school of the participants.
- 12. **SCHOOL REPRESENTATIVE** No team or individual will be permitted to participate unless accompanied by a coach or school representative.
- 13. STATE TOURNAMENT PLAY Stroke play, for thirty-six (36) holes.
- 14. **OUTSIDE FOOD AND BEVERAGE** Reminder to coaches, participants, and fans: Food/beverage and coolers are not permitted to be brought onto the golf courses.
- 15. **CARTS FOR SPECTATORS** there are no spectator carts available for purchase / rental. There will be handicap shuttling provided throughout the course.



FAQ OHSAA State Golf Tournament Ohio State Golf Club

- This event is all about the student athletes. Our goal is to deliver an exceptional experience for them!
 <u>Can spectators rent carts?</u>
- There will not be any spectator carts rented out for the event. The Ohio State Golf Club will provide a shuttle service for Friday/Saturday of the tournament for those that need handicap assistance. Please check in with the Golf Shop for assistance. We do not rent carts under any circumstance. Both courses come together at many points and without a continuous path around the entire course it is dangerous and potentially disruptive.
 - <u>Can coaches with a handicap placard rent a cart?</u>
- Coaches that need a handicap cart must register through OHSAA. OHSAA grants permission for handicap coached carts. Handicap coaches carts Friday/Saturday must be approved through OHSAA (weather permitting).

What is the range access for Thursday-Saturday?

- Range Fee: \$300 Team/\$75 Individual due on the Thursday practice round. Teams do not get credentials until the fee is paid. OSU Golf Club accepts Check, Cash or Credit Card.
- > The Ohio State Golf Club can provide a W9 Form to any school requesting one.
- Teams will be allowed to use the range/chipping green 30 minutes prior to their tee time on Thursday. They may putt as long as they want. The range/chipping green will not be available after the round on Thursday (Fair and equitable for all.)

How do teams get to #10 Gray?

Teams starting on Hole #10 Gray should plan on taking team vehicle to the McCoy Road Entrance. There will be parking for team vehicles only near the tee box. Ohio State Golf Club will provide a shuttle to #10 Gray if needed.

What other basic information is applicable to the event?

- In the case of inclement weather, teams should report back to the area they started in and go to their team vehicles for shelter.
- Weather updates/course updates... Ohio State Golf Club App/614-514-4653
- Dress code....Golf Shorts/Skorts/Pants....Shirts must have sleeves and/or a collar for girls. Shirts must have sleeves and a collar for boys.

Can teams bring food or coolers onto the property?

- Teams are permitted to bring food & beverage onto the property, but all coolers must remain in the team vehicle.
- Spectators may purchase food & beverage in the pub (To Go Items) and the McCoy Road Tent (Behind #9Gray/#14 Scarlet Greens)

Can spectators come out for practice round on Thursday?

- Spectators may come out on Thursday. There is no charge for the practice round.
- Spectators must purchase tickets online through the OHSAA website to gain admittance on Friday/Saturday.

Congratulations on Qualifying to the State Tournament

The OHSAA will be using the OHSAA Golf App by iWanamaker for live scoring at the State Tournament. The OHSAA Golf App is used to live score and view leaderboards, scorecards, rankings, etc.

If you already have the app:

- Please have your golfers create their own account on the **OHSAA Golf App** and register as a high school golfer for your team.
- Make sure that all of your golfers that qualified have the app. [] Have them get the OHSAA Golf App from the app store and sign up as a high school golfer.
- Log in at https://iwanamaker.com and Seed your golfers in the same order as they played at the district.

If you do not have the app:

- The first step is to get the OHSAA Golf App from the app store and sign up as a coach.
- The second step is to sign in at https://iwanamaker.com and navigate to your school by clicking the iWanamaker logo and then your school. [] Your school's homepage is where you will be able to manage your rosters and events.
- Although you could enter your golfers manually, they need to be registered users to be able to enter scores.
