Information for State Golf Tournament Qualifiers

1. **DATE** - October 6 & 7, 2025.
2. **LOCATION** – Heatherwoode Golf Club; 88 Heatherwoode Blvd, Springboro, OH 45066
3. **SITE MANAGER** – Tom West; General Manager, Heatherwoode Golf Club twest@cityofspringboro.com
4. **COACHES MEETING** - There will be a meeting in the Club House on Sunday, October 5 at 4:00 P.M. with coaches or school representatives of Girls Division II schools.
5. **GREEN FEES** - Paid by the OHSAA.
6. **PRACTICE ROUNDS** - Team (5 individuals only) and individual qualifiers may play a practice round on Sunday prior to the start of the tournaments. Each individual shall play one ball only during their practice round. Practice rounds are optional and limited to the day before the tournament. Tee times are pre-arranged. **District tournament managers will inform qualifying teams and individuals of their respective times.**

Girls Division II practice round at Heatherwoode Golf Club will begin with tee times at 12:00 P.M.

Note: Once teams or individuals have qualified for the state tournament, play on the course where they will play (Heatherwoode Golf Club) in the state tournament is not permitted. Ethics and integrity are of the utmost importance in regard to this regulation. Failure to comply may result in disqualification

7. **MANDATORY PRE-PAY RANGE FEE - \$300 for team, \$60 for individual**
Must be paid when picking up packet prior to practice round on Thursday. **Check should be made payable to: Heatherwoode Golf Club.**
8. **ADMISSIONS** - Admissions to the State Golf Tournament will be \$16.00 per day.
9. **PASSES** - Passes shall be provided to competitors and coaches according to the following schedule:
 - 9.1 - Individuals - number of qualifiers plus two coach passes
 - 9.2 - Team – seven total passes
10. **USGA Rules** – USGA Rules will be played in the State Tournament if conditions permit.
11. **RESPONSIBILITY** - Transportation, meals, and lodging shall be the responsibility of the school of the participants.
12. **SCHOOL REPRESENTATIVE** - No team or individual will be permitted to participate unless accompanied by a coach or school representative.
13. **STATE TOURNAMENT PLAY** - Stroke play, for thirty-six (36) holes.
14. **OUTSIDE FOOD AND BEVERAGE** - Reminder to coaches, participants, and fans: Food/beverage and coolers are not permitted to be brought onto the golf courses.
15. **CARTS FOR SPECTATORS** – there are no spectator carts available for purchase / rental. There will be handicap shuttling provided throughout the course

Heatherwoode Golf Club is excited to host the 2025 Girls DII Championship and partner with the OHSAA and Miami Valley Golf to provide an outstanding and memorable experience for the coaches, players, families and spectators while at our facility.

Golf Carts

- *Coaches:** Each school will receive one (1) golf cart for use by their coach. The fee is \$60 for all three days and must be paid either before or after the coaches' meeting at 4:30 on Sunday in the Heritage room downstairs.
- *Spectators:** A limited number of spectators carts will be available 1 hour prior to the first tee time (8:00) for those with a current handicap placard only-must provide the placard. Carts are \$40 per cart. Carts must remain on the cart path for the entire round and will be controlled by geofencing.

Practice Facility

*Driving Range

Sunday: Range balls will be available in baskets on the tee 1 hour before the start of the first practice round at 12:30 (11:30 availability).

Monday: Range balls will be available in baskets on the tee 1 hour prior to the first tee time at 9:00 (8:00 availability). School logos will be attached to holders that will mark the players warm up space. 2 bays will be allotted per team, 1 bay per individual player. Players may warm up at their own leisure before their tee time. The fee is \$60 per individual for all three days, \$300 per team for all three days and must be paid either before or after the coaches' meeting on Sunday.

*Short Game

The putting and chipping greens are located at the end of the driving range. Players have full access to these areas all three days with no restrictions.

Food and Beverage

***The Bunker:** The Bar & Grill will be open from 7:30am-6:00pm. Beverages, snacks, hot and cold food items will be available. Cash and cards accepted, no tap to pay options available.

Golf Shop

The golf shop is available to all visitors. Cash or credit card accepted as well as tap to pay options. Hours of operation are 7:00am-6:30pm daily.

Miscellaneous

*Restrooms

Clubhouse- both men's and women's restrooms are in the upstairs hallway and just outside of the Bunker in the downstairs level.

Outside of the clubhouse- both men's and women's restrooms are located just beyond the stairs and ADA ramp on the parking lot side of the building.

On course restrooms are located at #7 tee and #13 green, both have bottle filling stations.



***Tickets**

Spectators are welcome at no charge on Sunday for the practice round, no spectator carts will be available. Tournament rounds: spectators must have a ticket purchased from the OHSAA.

***Parking**

School vans can park in our parking lot. For large buses please contact the golf shop for parking instructions.

***Broadcast**

We will be live streaming the tournament on the City of Springboro's YouTube channel on both tournament days. The jumbo scoreboard located at the end of the driving range will also show the broadcast stream.

The OHSAA will be using the **OHSAA Golf App** by **iWanamaker** for live scoring at the State Tournament. The **OHSAA Golf App** is used to live score and view leaderboards, scorecards, rankings, etc.

If you already have the app:

- Please have your golfers create their own account on the **OHSAA Golf App** and register as a high school golfer for your team.
- Make sure that all of your golfers that qualified have the app. ☐ Have them get the **OHSAA Golf App** from the app store and sign up as a high school golfer.
- Log in at <https://iwanamaker.com> and **Seed** your golfers in the same order as they played at the district.

If you do not have the app:

- **The first step** is to get the **OHSAA Golf App** from the app store and sign up as a coach.
- **The second step** is to sign in at <https://iwanamaker.com> and navigate to your school by clicking the iWanamaker logo and then your school. ☐ Your school's homepage is where you will be able to manage your rosters and events.
- Although you could enter your golfers manually, they need to be registered users to be able to enter scores.
