- In BLX, 5 schools went up to D1 and 4 schools went down to D2

The 2023 tournament regions assignments will not be finalized until the February 2023 Board of Directors meeting when the tournament regulations are approved. Due to the relatively low number of changes summarized above, I do not anticipate many changes in region assignments for schools from 2022 to 2023.

<u>2 – Change to Regulation on Individual Skill Instruction</u>
There has been a change to OHSAA General Sport Regulation 7.10, please review the full details in the link below.

In summary, the modification expands the number of groups of students that can receive individual skill instruction at the same time and in the same facility. Previously, this regulation limited individual skill instruction to a single group of students in all facilities.
