## **NFHS Questionnaire**

You have been invited to take part in the NFHS rules-writing process by taking the annual soccer rules questionnaire. #### **Individual Instruction**

Individual instruction may occur in the off-season any time outside of the no contact period. The individual instruction regulation is designed to provide just that... individual instruction. This means that you may only work with 4 individuals in all combined facilities. You cannot have 4 players with you in the gym, 4 players with your assistant in another gym and 4 players running drills with a volunteer assistant outside. It is 4 IN ALL COMBINED FACILITIES. The regulation was created to give individual attention to a small group of individuals. Even if you have 1 athlete from last year's team and 3 players who have never played soccer before, the limit is still 4.

## **Friday Night Futbol**

Friday Night Futbol will be held on <u>August 21</u> next year. We hope to once again partner with the Columbus Crew to offer tickets for you to raffle during the game. You will receive more information on this in the summer.

## **Ejections**
