The information below is **NOT** the final list of schools that will be eligible to participate in the 2020 tournament, as schools have until October 5 to make changes to their tournament participation. In addition, multi-high school districts that restructure their high schools are required to have their enrollment reclassified as of September 10, which may change their assigned tournament division.

## **OHSAA's Raising Cane's Partnership:**

Restaurant chain, Raising Canes Ohio has entered into a partnership with OHSAA to provide funding for student-athlete scholarship programs, and support for postseason tournaments. ## Soccer Coach Association:

The OSSCA voted to move to a statewide online membership system. Due to the Coronavirus and the economic uncertainty for many, the OSSCA has decided to reduce state dues for the 2020 season from \$20 to \$15. The OSSCA just renewed a partnership with the United Soccer Coaches for a higher rate with many additional perks for OSSCA members but in discussion with the United Soccer Coaches they will not increase dues for OSSCA members and the dues will remain at \$60 for the 2020 season. Basic membership with the United Soccer Coaches is \$125 but all OSSCA will pay \$60 for the 2020 season. A new partnership agreement will be discussed in January of 2021 with the United Soccer Coaches. The OSSCA voted to have a statewide deadline for membership registration of September 1 which is 11 days into the regular season.

## Friday Night Futbol & Future Dates:

Friday Night Futbol is currently still planned for <u>August 21</u>. The Columbus Crew continues to be a great partner, and we are working together to ensure that Friday Night Futbol happens in 2020.
