TICKETING/ENTRY:

Tickets are required for entry into Lower.com Field for this event. All tickets will be digital and can be purchased through Hometown Ticketing <https://www.ohsaa.org/tickets> or Ticketmaster.com. Guests 5 and under do not need a ticket. Patrons should enter the AEP gate located off Nationwide Blvd on the Southeast corner of the stadium. There is **NO REENTRY during this event.**

SEATING SECTIONS:

Seating for the event will be general admission and first come first served on the East side of Lower.com Field only –

- Home Team: Sections 132 to 137
- Visiting Team: Sections 139 to 144

SECURITY SCREENING: Guests will go through Evolv security to enter the stadium. Information about Evolv here: <https://www.evolvtechnology.com/>. Blankets are permitted in the stadium, but guests will be asked to unfold/ shake out the blanket upon entry. There will be no access to certain areas of Lower.com Field and the Field area for this event.

BAG POLICY: Lower.com Field allows clutch style wallets that are 5" X 8" X 1" and smaller into the venue. Any bags larger than the allotted size will not be allowed in, all bags are subject to inspection. Approved medical/diaper bags are permitted and will be searched at the gate.

PROHIBITED ITEMS: No outside food or beverage is permitted inside Lower.com Field. Empty clear plastic water bottles will be allowed. Posters, flags, and banners must be smaller than 3'X5' and may not include profanity, political slogans, or anything deemed inappropriate by security staff. - Cashless Venue – Lower.com Field is a cashless venue – Cash 2 Card Kiosks are located on the main concourse at **Section 142 and in the Crew Team store.**

- Guest Services – Guests may visit Guest Services Table at Section 101 for event information, KultureCity Sensory kits, etc.
- Restrooms – Restrooms, including family restrooms will be open on the main concourse of lower.com field.
- Smoking/Vaping – Lower.com Field is a smoke free venue; guests may smoke away from the stadium on the community plaza.

FAMILY AREAS:

- Home team can visit with their parents in the in the Tipico Sports Biergarten area on the north end of the stadium following awards ceremony at Section 129. Athletes will meet their families there.
- Visiting team can visit with their parents in the Land Grant Patio on the South end of the stadium at Section 105.
